The home must be:

- Freehold, landed, and located in the Klang Valley (with certain postcodes excluded)
- Owner-occupied as the senior's primary place of residence
- Free from encumbrances, such as mortgages or other financial liabilities (All property taxes, management fees, and utility bills must be fully paid and up to date)
- Not situated on Malay Reserved Land, not a low-cost or medium-cost affordable home, and not a designated Bumiputera unit
- Supported by a valid and effective legal title under the senior's name
- Supported by a valid CCC/CF (Certificate of Completion & Compliance / Certificate of Fitness)
- Able to meet KALSIS property evaluation criteria
