If you do not have health insurance or have insurance that doesn't fully meet your healthcare needs, you may be eligible for **free addiction treatment services** through Delaware's Division of Substance Abuse and Mental Health (DSAMH).  **Ask your physician to make a referral** through the Delaware Treatment and Referral Network (DTRN)/OpenBeds.

 **Visit or call your local DSAMH Bridge Clinic.** Bridge Clinic staff will conduct an assessment to determine what treatment is right for you. Bridge Clinics can offer short-term outpatient treatment, counseling, peer support, care coordination, and same or next day buprenorphine treatment, before linking you with a long-term treatment option.

Most addiction treatment programs start with a **comprehensive assessment** – administered by an addiction specialist or other clinician – to understand your needs and inform your treatment plan. **To get an assessment, call or visit a Bridge Clinic or call the other programs listed on page 3.**

Who can I call if I am in crisis?

Call 911 for medical emergencies.

Call or text 988 for mental health or addiction-related crises.

What types of programs are available?

Outpatient

Outpatient programs provide clinic-based services, including education, support, individual and group counseling, and medications to help achieve recovery.

Intensive Outpatient and Partial Hospitalization Programs

Intensive outpatient programs provide clinic-based services, including individual and group counseling, peer support, case management, and medications to help achieve recovery.

Residential

Residential treatment programs provide a place to stay in a supportive community while individuals participate in outpatient or intensive outpatient treatment.

Inpatient (Hospital)

Around the clock medical care with doctors and nurses managing complex withdrawal, psychiatric or medical issues.

Many addiction treatment programs include the following services:

Medications for Opioid Use Disorder

(MOUD): These highly effective medications – such as methadone, buprenorphine, and naltrexone – help stop withdrawal symptoms and cravings and are usually prescribed or administered in a clinic setting. The program directory on page 3 indicates which programs provide MOUD with this symbol: .

Case management services: Trained professionals help you gain access to medical, social, educational services, and other resources.

Peer services: Peer Recovery Specialists support you in your recovery from addiction, mental health conditions, or both. Peer Recovery Specialists are specially trained individuals who have maintained their own successful recovery and help others through shared understanding, respect, and mutual empowerment.

Counseling: Professional counselors help you identify goals and potential solutions to problems you are facing, improve your communication and coping skills, strengthen your self-esteem, and help you make changes in your life that support your mental wellbeing and recovery.

Where can I get publicly funded treatment?

It is recommended that you do not visit the addresses listed below before contacting the program. The  symbol identifies which programs provide medications for opioid use disorder.

Please note: This is not a full list of all treatment providers in Delaware. The providers on this list have a contract with the state to provide **free** treatment services to people who do not have health insurance or whose health insurance doesn't fully meet their healthcare needs.

Where can I get Naloxone (commonly called “Narcan”) and other harm reduction resources?

Access Naloxone

Naloxone, commonly known as Narcan, is a lifesaving medication that can reverse an opioid overdose in minutes. Free Naloxone is available through Bridge Clinics, DSAMH training events, community partners, harm reduction vending machines, and mail-order.

Syringe Services Program

Brandywine Counseling and Community Services and Impact Life operate syringe services programs in Delaware. SSPs provide sterile supplies, naloxone, safe disposal, overdose prevention education, infectious disease prevention, and connections to treatment, recovery, health care, and other supports. Drug-Checking Tools

Fentanyl, xylazine, and medetomidine test strips are from most naloxone distribution partners statewide. These tools can help identify possible contaminants in the drug supply. Drug checking does not make drug use safe, but it can support safer decisions and overdose prevention. BCCS, Impact Life and DSAMH PORT teams also provide lab-based street drug testing services.

Harm Reduction Vending Machines

Delaware has harm reduction vending machines that provide free supplies 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Supplies may include naloxone, test strips, and other harm reduction resources. (if space is low, we can remove the addresses)
