Construction Corps Named a Finalist for the 16th Annual GrowFL Florida Companies to Watch Awards

Statewide awards program recognizes high-growth, second-stage companies driving Florida's economy forward

August 13, 2026 | Clearwater, FL – Construction Corps, Inc. has been named a finalist for the 16th Annual GrowFL Florida Companies to Watch Awards, a statewide recognition program celebrating high-growth, second-stage companies headquartered in Florida. Finalist companies are recognized for strong leadership, innovation, growth potential, and meaningful contributions to their communities, industries, and Florida's economy.

The GrowFL Florida Companies to Watch Awards, made possible through the support of Nperspective CFO & Strategic Services, celebrates privately held second-stage companies that are helping strengthen and diversify Florida's economy.

This year, more than 500 companies were nominated for the GrowFL Florida Companies to Watch Awards. Following the nomination and application process, 95 finalists were selected to move forward in the judging process, reflecting the strength, innovation, and impact of Florida's second-stage business community.

To be considered, companies must be headquartered in Florida, employ six to 150 full-time equivalent employees, generate \$750,000 to \$100 million in annual revenue or working capital, and demonstrate both the intent and capacity to grow.

Since its founding in 2022 by U.S. Army combat veteran Matt Thompson, a licensed general contractor since 2007 (originally in California) with more than 30 years in the trades, Construction Corps has grown from a standing start to approximately \$8 million in annual revenue by 2025 while building a W-2 field workforce and in-house staff spanning engineering, design, estimating, project management, and operations. The company is co-owned and led by Matt and his wife, Vice President Serena Lorien, with Director of Construction George Thompson leading field operations. Construction Corps holds six Florida licenses in-house (general contracting, engineering, electrical, plumbing, mold remediation, and mold assessment), allowing the company to self-perform work most general contractors subcontract out, and serves residential, commercial, and government clients across the Tampa Bay area. The company holds active SBA certifications as a Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business (SDVOSB) and Veteran-Owned Small Business (VOSB) and is registered for federal contracting.

Companies are evaluated on growth, innovation, response to adversity, community involvement, and overall impact on Florida's economy.

"This recognition belongs to our team," said Matt Thompson, founder and CEO of Construction Corps. "We started this company in 2022 with a simple idea: run a construction business the way veterans serve, with discipline, accountability, and mission completion. Being named a finalist alongside some of the best second-stage companies in Florida tells our clients and our crews that the work they put in every day is getting noticed statewide."

Finalists will move forward in the judging process for consideration as one of the top 50 GrowFL Florida Companies to Watch Honorees. They will also be recognized at regional events held throughout Florida, with registration available at growfl.com. The 50 honorees will be announced in October and celebrated at the 16th Annual GrowFL Florida Companies to Watch Awards Gala on Friday, February 26, 2027, at Hard Rock Live, Universal CityWalk in Orlando.

“We are proud to recognize this year’s finalists and the role they play in advancing Florida’s economy,” said Robert Newland, Chief Growth Advisor, Newland Growth Advisors and Chair of the Board for GrowFL. “These companies represent the innovation, resilience, and entrepreneurial leadership that make Florida a strong place to grow a business.”
