Choose a sentence that illustrates the tone the author was using or shows how a simple or complex sentence can help to emphasise or illustrate an idea.  E.g. 'I didn't know it then, but I know it now: that's what it feels like when you're on country after an absence' (Natalie Cromb, p62) or 'Please forgive me (Don Bemrose, p27).
