 that throughout the world, only 59% of children go to secondary school?

- Decide how you will compile and communicate your information? E.g., a poster, PowerPoint, brochure, writing a letter. It is also helpful to consider who you are communication your findings to E.g., parents, students, business, local council, community groups etc.
