#### Conduct your data investigation

- Pose a question about the village. You should be able to answer this question using statistics.
- Choose a data set that will help you answer your question.
- Represent the data visually.
  - Can you do this using two different graphs?
  - Have a go at representing your data in 3D model (optional). What graph is most effective? Why?
  - What questions can you ask and answer about your data?
- Become 'experts' in your field. Find out more about your topic. For example, if you choose to investigate *Who goes to school?* You could research other facts about global education. Did you know that *throughout the world, only 59% of children go to secondary school?*

#### Communicate your findings

- Decide how you will compile and communicate your information? E.g., a poster, PowerPoint, brochure, writing a letter. It is also helpful to consider who you are communicating your findings to E.g., parents, students, business, local council, community groups etc.
- Include the following information:
  - A title
  - Your question
