COURSE OBJECTIVES	Course participants learn how to identify the constituent elements of woven textiles according to the methods proposed by the Centre International d'Etude des Textiles Anciens. Observation of historical samples in varying states of conservation, modern reconstructions and contemporary wovens. Students study the conventions of graphic representation of looms set-ups and weaves.		
INTENDED FOR	Textile historians, scholars, students, and all those who wish to augment their knowledge of the structural aspects of woven textiles. The course will be held in English language. Clarifications and explanations available also in Italian language.

PROGRAM

- 3h Fiber identification. (2h theory 1h practice)
- 2h Yarns: twist, plying, decorative effects. (1 ½ h theory ½ h practice)
- 1h The shaft loom. (theory)
- 1h Woven textile terminology, definition of warp, weft. Various weave drafting methods: lyonnaise, cross sections, drawdown on squared or pointpaper. (theory)
- 1h The C.I.E.T.A. record. (theory)

Basic weaves and their derivatives:

- 4h Taffetas and plain weave: striped, banded and checked effects, chiné and moiré. (2h theory 2h practice)
- 3h Plain weave derivatives: louisine, gros de Tours, royale, reps alternatif, factise effects. (2h theory 1h practice)
- 2h Warps on double and triple ends, paired, tripled and quadrupled wefts.

 Distinction between a taffetas with double and triple ends and louisine weave

 Distinction between taffetas with paired, triple, or quadruple weft and derivatives

 With two, three or four picks. (theory)
- 4h Twills: warp effects, weft effects, complex twills, chevron, losange twill. (2h theory 2h practice)
- 3h Satin: shift, regular and irregular satins. (2h theory 1h practice)
- 4h Double-faced weaves in warp and weft direction. Double cloths. (2 $\frac{1}{2}$ h theory 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ h practice)
- 3h Gauze and mock leno. (2 ½ theory ½ h practice)
- 3h Combined weaves: pékin and bayadere (1 ½ theory 1 ½ h practice)
- 4h Double warp weaves: faille, cannelé, canetillé, velour ottoman, poil traînant, plain velvets (2 $\frac{1}{2}$ theory 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ h practice)
- 2h Review and evaluation. (1h theory 1 h practice)
