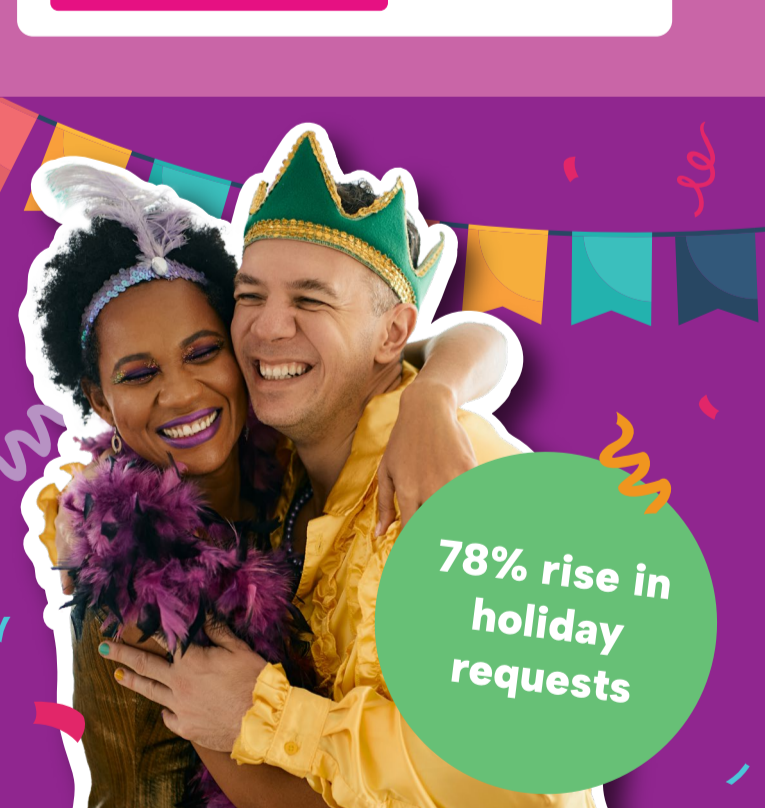


Pride Celebrations

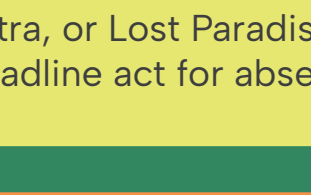

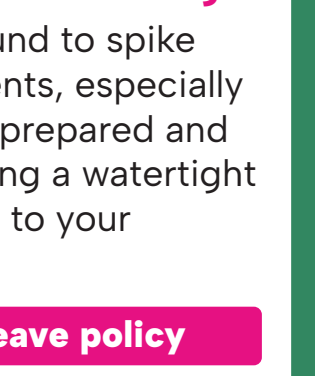
Employees score a day off after Women's FIFA World Cup Final

2023 was another mammoth year for sport. The **Women's FIFA World cup** took place as hosted by Australia and New Zealand, with **love for the Matildas sweeping the nation**.

While the Matildas couldn't quite win the trophy this time around, they won hearts around the nation. 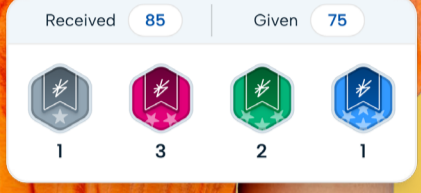
