## A Letter From Fr. Frank

Wednesday, May 25, is a somber day in our country as we remember the horrific death of George Floyd at the hands of a police officer. On the first year anniversary of his killing, we acknowledge the sin of racism that keeps surfacing, sometimes in explosive acts of violence, but I often in ways more subtle and under the surface. The latter are actually more dangerous because hidden attitudes of hatred have the ability to permeate our culture in insidious ways.

Combatting and facing racism is not something simply tackled in workshops or protest marches, as necessary as they are. But each and everyone of us must consistently and daily face our own biases, a lifelong endeavor. ALL liturgies and catechetical formation must encourage the plague of racism to be faced and named, so that healing and contrition can happen. The prayer of the Eucharist is the means to lift up our hearts in sorrow for the divisions within the human family, called to become a "holy family" of many colors and expressions. The Eucharist demands that the truth be spoken so that we can be freed to love without limits
