2021 Avila in Action Winners

Humble Designs \$7500

Humble Design serves families, individuals, foster-youth, and veterans emerging from homelessness by transforming their empty apartment or house into a home--a simple idea that can change a family's future. Newly furnished homes become the launching point for new careers, the catalyst for improved family dynamics, and the motivation to pay it forward. Humble Design attempts to disrupt the cycle of homelessness by encouraging a stable environment for clients to build a brighter future for themselves. Humble Design's Chicago warehouse is curated and stocked with donated and recycled furniture, beds, and home goods from the local community. Humble Design provides professional level interior design services along with the transportation and installation of all home furnishings for our clients at no cost. Clients transitioning from homelessness have reported that acquiring furniture is the most challenging part about moving into their new housing. The furnishings provided by Humble Design help Chicago families with a fresh start creating ownership, dignity, and stability. Humble Design differentiates itself from the other similar service providers through the level of detail and focus we bring to each client interaction. Each client interaction is our opportunity to make the client feel respected, loved and heard. We go out of our way to provide the most 'GOOD' for the people we serve.

HighSight \$5000

HighSight works with high school students from low-income families throughout Chicago who are attending 16 different Catholic and private schools, with the vast majority being Latino and African American students. The average family income for our students is \$29,500. Two-thirds of these students scored below the 65th percentile on standardized tests before joining HighSight. Briefly describe the program or initiative

HighSight currently serves 102 high school students in our four-year HighSight Scholars initiative, with students averaging a program-wide 3.61 GPA, more than .50 higher than their peers at the same high schools. HighSight is also providing college-access programming for 62 additional senior-year students through our Project College initiative, and there are also more than 140 HighSight alumni currently in college. 100% of HighSight scholars graduate from high school, and 100% of our four-year students enroll in college on a full-tuition scholarship. 85% of these students attend a college ranked in the top one-fifth of institutions nationally. 74% of HighSight scholars graduate from college within four years and nearly 85% in six years, both 6 to 8 times the national average for their socioeconomic peers.

HighSight provide scholarships, tutoring, mentoring, leadership development, and college-readiness programs for our students in Catholic and other private high schools in Chicago. This experience empowers our scholars to excel in high school and graduate from four-year colleges across the country.

Bethany House of Hospitality \$5000

Bethany House of Hospitality provides housing, shelter and support services for young, immigrant women who have journeyed or have been trafficked to this country from 17 countries around the world, and have been held in detention centers, primarily in Chicago, Texas and New York. As they reach the age of 18, Bethany House welcomes them as an alternative to placement in adult detention centers as they age out of centers designated for youth. Bethany House began in 2017 when several congregations of religious women realized the need for immigrant services for young women, most of whom had undertaken harrowing journeys and had been subjected to abuse and trauma in their countries of origin or in transit to the US.

Marillac St Vincent Family Services \$2500

Each year, Marillac St. Vincent Family Services' commitment to the less fortunate positively impacts the lives of over 10,000 clients across all programs to fulfill our mission to strengthen, empower and give voice to those in need – in the Vincentian spirit of service – through education and comprehensive programs to build vibrant communities in Chicago. St Vincent de Paul Center, located in Chicago's Lincoln Park neighborhood, and Marillac Social Center on the near west side, draws families from 51 communities across the Chicago area. For more than a century, these Centers have been sanctuaries in the city, providing refuge to at-risk individuals and families facing poverty, violence, gang affiliation, unemployment, homelessness, isolation, and an abiding lack of opportunity.
