

I met Dan in 1991 when I became a resident priest here at St. Teresa's while teaching at Archbishop Quigley. I used to visit Dan in the basement of the old Ace Hardware right on Armitage. It was here that I learned about the history and transformation of Lincoln Park. He actually brought together various gang members to try and broker some peace!!! I learned more from him about this area from its beginnings in a study sponsored by the Kiwanis, an organization dear to Dan.

We all miss Dan so much and our hearts go out to Kathleen and the rest of his beautiful family. They put together a moving celebration to celebrate "unveil" the sign designating that corner in honor of Dan. Every time you are walking east on Armitage, just past the El station, just look up and see Dan's name and remember a beautiful man who was a part of St. Teresa's since 1969!!!
