Finance Update

St. Teresa's fiscal year ended June 30, 2021. The Finance Council planned for our most financially challenging year in recent memory due to the pandemic. However, this year's results exceeded our expectations and the prior year thanks to your continued generosity, higher investment earnings, and release from repayment of a PPP loan. As outlined in the table, fiscal 2021 net income equaled \$234k, \$219k higher than the prior year and \$353k higher than the budget. Results are explained further below.

Net Ordinary Results: 2021 net ordinary results, excluding investment earnings, equaled \$83k, slightly lower than last year and \$128k higher than the budget. The better-than-expected result largely reflected record fundraising results and your continued weekly support through Give Central. Collections exceeded budget, but declined somewhat versus last year, reflecting the suspension of in person Mass from March to July 2020 and resumption thereafter at reduced capacity.

Net Other Results: 2021 net other results, excluding PPP loan release, equaled a loss of \$94k, \$10k better than last year and \$16k favorable versus budget. Other expense decreased by \$73k versus last year due to lower capital improvements spending, the absence of expenses covered by insurance (the absence of the insurance recovery reduced other revenue), and lower Avila in Action grants. This year's larger capital projects included the completion of the audiovisual project and the replacement of both air conditioning units.

Investment Earnings and PPP Loan: The higher investment earnings resulted from the previously announced February 2021 shift of certain assets to the Archdiocese's Growth Fund. The Growth Fund involves more risk and greater volatility than our prior investment in a CD but is expected to generate higher returns over the long-term. The Parish was released from repayment of a PPP loan in May 2021.

Looking Ahead: Earlier this year, we reviewed and approved the budget for fiscal 2022. The coming year's budget plans for a modest surplus as we gradually emerge from the pandemic. Social distancing restrictions on Mass were completely lifted as of June 2021, but the virus persists, and weekly attendance remains below pre-pandemic levels.
