

Parish Life

From Fr. Frank- May Fest:

I would like to let all parishioners know about a neighborhood festival that has been planned for the weekend of May 20-22, Friday through late Sunday/Monday morning. During this entire weekend, Armitage Avenue will be closed from Sheffield to Racine, which definately impacts St. Teresa's. We just found out about this festival during Holy Week, which has necessitated some changes in some of the Sacramental celebrations for that weekend.

Our Confirmation has been scheduled for May 22 at Noon. Given the logistical problems of parking and the large number of people attending, I have decided to move the Confirmation to St. Josaphat's and they have been so gracious and understanding of our sitiutation. The Mass will be the same time, Noon, but at St. Josaphat's with Bishop Bartosic presiding and I will concelebrate. There is a parking lot in back of the church off of Wayne Street.

Our French community has scheduled their Confirmation and First Communion for that Saturday May 21st at 6:30pm. They are searching to find an available church that can accommodate them at that particular time, so they can avoid the parking lot issues.

St. Teresa's will have the normal three Masses at 10:00am, Noon and 6:00pm. Parishioners CAN get into the lot

via Seminary but must exit the lot from the alley back onto Seminary, since the entrance/exit on Armitage will be closed. I encourage those who live close and are able, to walk to Mass. If you live a bit of a distance, please consider using public transportation.

Unfortunately, the archdiocese is asking all parishes for a count of how many people attend the masses on that weekend and the weekend prior. I believe this is to assess the impact of COVID on attendance. PLEASE make every effort to come to mass over those two weekends.

Our Loaves and Fishes and our Food Pantry will go on as normal. Nothing will prevent these ministries from taking place. The organization planning of MayFest has been very helpful in assuring us that they understand the importance of our outreach to the homeless and those struggling to put food on their tables. Also, they will make certain no music or bands will be played during the celebration of the Masses, particularly the 6:00pm.
