Wine Competition Rules

1. Entry Qualifications and Conditions:

- a. Any commercial wine produced by a professional winery that complies with the classification codes may enter.
- b. There is no limit to the number of entries per winery.
- c. No wine may be entered more than once in the same year by an entrant, even if it is marketed under different labels.
- d. Wine entered in previous competitions are welcome.
- e. Each winery winning a Sweepstakes or Double Gold medal award agrees to provide the San Francisco International Wine Competition with one (1) bottle for display purposes, if requested.

2. Sending Your Entry Form and Fee(s):

<u>Do not send wine with your entry form and fee(s).</u> See below for wine shipping instructions.

Your completed entry form and fee(s) must be received at the Competition office by May 28.

The entry fee is \$85 per wine entered.

3. Sending Your Wines:

<u>Do not send entry fees with your wines.</u> See above for mailing instructions concerning forms and fees.

All wine must be received at the Competition warehouse by May 28.

Send five (5) 750 ml. bottles per entry <u>and a copy of your completed</u> entry form to:

- For shipments from outside the U.S., if you are not using your U.S. importer, you <u>must</u> contact our customs broker, SDV (USA), Inc., at usa.winedesk@sdvusa.com. To reduce customs charges, SDV will arrange for your shipment and may consolidate shipments with others in your area. The San Francisco International Wine Competition is not responsible for customs duty charges or fees.
- WRITE ON THE BOXES: "SAMPLE MATERIALS. NOT FOR RESALE. GLASS ENCLOSED."
- For shipments of more than one box, indicate that the box is "Box 1 of 4," "Box 2 of 4," etc.
- Please use eco-friendly shippers whenever possible.

Wine Label Competition Rules

- 1. For entries in the label competition, the label must be judged on the bottle.
- 2. Wine labels will be judged in two categories:
 - a. Individual Label.
 - b. Overall Label Series: a label series consists of at least two different labels and not more than five different labels.

3. Wine label judging:

- a. The labels will be judged by nationally recognized graphic design experts.
- b. The judges have determined the following criteria for judging the labels:
 - overall originality and creativity
 - use of typography and graphics
 - overall package appearance
- 4. Awards for the Wine Label Competition will be mailed after the judging and will consist of Double Gold, Gold, Silver, and Bronze awards in both the Individual and Series categories. The Competition reserves the right to photograph and reproduce any label entered in the Competition in catalogs, posters, publications, and publicity printed by the Competition. Each entrant assents to this condition.

5. To enter your wine labels:

Each wine entry will, within reason and at the discretion of the Judging Director and Managing Director, be evaluated within a peer group of similar wines. However, the Events Directors reserve the right to arrange categories as they see fit in light of the number of entries.

San Francisco International Wine Competition awards will be made on a merit basis. The judges will not grant awards when, in their opinion, wines are unworthy of recognition.



2010 Wine Classification Rules and Codes

- 1. All blended wines must have varietal percentages indicated on the application form.
- 2. All varietal wines must contain at least 75% of the varietal, or it must be entered in a blend category.
- 3. All entries with residual sugar over 0.1% must have residual sugar % stated on the entry form.
- 4. Library wines are those that were in commercial release prior to June 1, 2001. Wines will be judged in age group categories.
