

## IV. PORTUGIESER DU MONDE<sup>®</sup> 2016

We steadfastly believe: Portugieser is an essential and important grape variety in Central Europe, it is however unfortunately rarely celebrated in the world of wines. We began four years ago by organising a tasting event with Portugiesers from Villány, extended the competition to be international three years ago and we are organising the Portugieser du Monde® wine competition this year as well.

## PORTUGIESER DU MONDE® INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION

The Portugieser variety is spread across Central Europe, called either Portugizer, Portugizac, Portugalka, Blauer Portugieser or Modrý Portugal. It would be very nice to see all ranges of these wines at once. We organise the international Portugieser variety competition for the fourth time this year, on the first day of our event, 1 April, and the wines compete at an international jury.

Wines may be submitted to the Portugieser du Monde competition in the following four categories:

- young Portugiesers (vintage of 2015);
- vintage Portugiesers (vintages 2014 or earlier);
- blends with a min. 25 percent Portugieser-content.
- white, rosé and sparkling (min. 85% portugieser)
