Czech booth (H89) is talking to each visitor by circles and rounded shapes so typical for winemaking. The representation is unbelievably colourful: meet micro, family, boutique winemakers beside the representants of some biggest companies in the country.

You will find the winners and finalists of various important competitions in Czechia (Winery and Winemaker of the year, Czech National competition etc.) as well as successful exporters around the globe. Czech wine has already found its fans in many different countries from Japan, through the UK and Sweden over to the US and Canada.

Moravian and Bohemian white wines are characterized by their fascinating spectrum of aromas, rich extractive substances and harmonious combination of full-bodied flavours along with fresh, vibrant acidity. Recently, red wines have also been gaining ground, which, thanks to modern technological processing, are full-bodied and expressive, yet soft and velvety, with a pleasant fruity aroma. Rosé wines are also keeping the trend - beautiful not only for their colour but also for their exceptional youthful character.

ABOUT:

IWAYINI is a young Moravian micro-winery, founded by Martin Zůl in 2020. Martin decided to focus on a few varieties from unique tracks and create harmonious wines that respect the given terroir. IWAYINI wines are divided into two lines according to their method of vinification. The ISIKO line contains lightweight drinkable, fresh and juicy wines. In the Umlando line hides more complex, layered wines that epitomize return to fermentation and maturation of wines in wooden barrels with longer work on yeast. Since the year 2023 the winery started using the method pressing of whole grapes in all batches. The winery has vineyard in Kurdějov, which has a unique closed microclimate, highly sloping tracks and great exposures.

Vines are tended with love and care, using an eco-friendly integrated production system. The winery produces wines in the process of controlled fermentation not only in stainless steel tanks; it also uses wooden barrels, concrete tanks, and quevri containers. THAYA vineyards are located in the wine region Znojemsko, a region typical for its full-flavoured and fresh wines. It is the River Dyje or Thaya, which, through its thermoregulatory influence, together with the cold winds from the Bohemian-Moravian Highlands, gives the local wines their unmistakable spicy taste and fullness. Thanks to the granitic subsoil and the loess with a mixture of calcareous clays, the Veltliner, Sauvignon and Riesling are particularly outstanding.

THAYA farms about 105 hectares of own vineyards located in the immediate vicinity of the winery and in the neighbouring wine-growing villages. The vineyards adjacent to the Podyjí National Park have been known since the ancient Romans for their unique sunny location.

THAYA winery is repeated finalist in competitions such as Winery of the Year and Winemaker of the Year, THAYA wines are also regularly successful in international competitions, and with each harvest the winery moves forward.

They're the one and only winery in the Czech Republic to carry the prestigious DEMETER label of biodynamic agriculture and their wines always ferment spontaneously without added yeast, then they like to work with fine lees to protect them. Wines age in French oak barrels of finest quality or in stainless steel. White wines are bottled after a gentle filtration, whereas the reds are usually bottled unfiltered.

Volařík Winery

The family winery, whose roots date back to 1945, entered the wine market under the name Vinařství Volařík in 2007. Winery manages 80 ha vineyards in the wine region Mikulovsko, of which 4.2 ha are in organic production. The winery focuses on the production of predicate wines, especially white wines, the offer is complemented by rosé, red wines and Volařík Sekt produced using the traditional method.
