PACKAGES OF CARE FOR THE ROYAL MELBOURNE HOSPITAL

Frontline workers have been incredible with keeping our community safe during the COVID-19 pandemic. For this, we thank all our partners and their employees.

In August, BankVic supported the Royal Melbourne Hospital by providing 83 Care Packages to their hardworking healthcare workers. The Care Packages included sweet and savoury delights to suit all tastes. During the year BankVic usually hosts BBQs for the staff at Royal Melbourne Hospital, however, the Care Packages this year have been our small way of saying thank you during these challenging times.

SUICIDE PREVENTION RESEARCH WITH FASTERN HEALTH.

Suicide remains a leading cause of preventable death in Australia. This year we are proud to be supporting Eastern Health and its research into better understanding the outcomes for people with mental health challenges when they access a hospital Emergency Department for treatment, but do not wait to see a health professional or mental health practitioner at the time.

Through this research, Eastern Health has so far discovered that around 4% of people who go to the hospital Emergency Department seeking mental health treatment leave before their assessment is complete. The continuing research hopes to find out if suicide can be prevented through the right intervention at the right time.

BankVic also supported Eastern Health and its work to support for prevention.

STADIUM STOMP VIRTUAL **SUPPORTING** THE EMERGENCY SERVICES FOUNDATION.

In support of The Emergency Services Foundation and our people's health and wellbeing, BankVic employees formed a team to take part in Stadium Stomp Virtual from Sunday 5 July to Tuesday 4 August.

Usually Stadium Stomp involves thousands of people climbing the stairs of Australia's biggest stadiums. This year the 25,000-stair challenge was completed throughout the month anywhere participants could find stairs or else we were able to do squats, lunges or step-ups as alternatives.

Michelle Arundel, Chief People & Culture Officer at BankVic said, "During the COVID-19 pandemic we wanted to support emergency services workers and encourage our people to stay active in their local neighbourhood, while following restrictions.

"The BankVic team climbed over 100,000 stairs and raised over \$1,600 from family, friends and colleagues. Thank you to all our amazing supporters and those who are on the frontline."

The Emergency Services Foundation has a dedicated focus on improving mental health and wellbeing for the Victorian emergency management sector. We look forward to doing it all again next year.
