CHRISTMAS FIRE -SIDE QUIZ

One of our grandparents has kindly prepared a Christmas Fireside Quiz, to be distributed to each child to help raise Nursery School funds. As you can appreciate, we have been required to purchase additional cleaning materials and two fogging machines, costing £1,000. We are using £15 per week (on average) on cleaning materials and have employed two temporary additional assistants to help with the supervision of hand washing, cleaning and help with the children. We would encourage each family to try and sell 10 fireside guizzes (or more) among family and friends to help recover these additional costs. "Together we can get through this."

OUTDOOR PLAY AND SELF HELP SKILLS

Responding to Covid-19 guidelines which require the children to remain in their class bubbles, we have been introducing outdoor play in a cyclical pattern. We are teaching the children the routine of putting on/taking off coats/welly boots as well as the safety rules of the garden, e.g.

- "feet first" down the slide; always look in the direction they are running in and coming into the welly boot store when they hear their teacher's musical instrument.

As the weather gets colder, the children will need warmer coats for outdoor play. Winter hats which tie under the child's chin and scarves are **not** allowed in the nursery playground for health and safety reasons. Please ensure that all clothing is named.

SCHOOL FUND MONEY

For those who have opted to pay monthly, £20 is now due for November. We are a non-profit nursery school and the school fund money is used entirely for your children i.e. birthday/Christmas presents, photographs, baking/playdough ingredients, healthy snack, fruit, vegetables, pumpkins etc. as well as contributing to the day to day running cost of the Nursery. Please pay promptly and pay directly by bank transfer if possible.
