PLAYFUL MUSEUMS

We are very grateful to Mid and East Antrim Council who have kindly offered to involve us again this year in their Playful Museums Event. In the past they have hosted us in The Braid Arts Centre for a multicultural celebration of Chinese New Year (pre-Covid) and last year

produced online resources relating to the history of Ballymena Castle (a building very close to our hearts as we are built on the site of the former castle).

This year they will be focusing on the Ballymena Market and its origins by talking to the children about the market and allowing them to participate in a related craft activity. This will take place during your child's nursery session on Tuesday 8th February. I'm sure, like us, you are looking forward to hearing all about it.

FAMILY PHOTOS

Photo sessions by appointment only

You have the opportunity to have your family portrait taken on Thursday 10th February between 5.30-7pm. You will need to book an appointment for this session. Please speak to a member of staff who will try to accommodate you with a suitable time.

If your child missed the individual photo session earlier in the year and you want their photo taken, this can also be booked for this date.

3+ REVIEWS

If your child is in their pre-school year, you will have received a form to be completed and returned to nursery, not later than Thursday 3rd February.

This is an important way of communicating with the health visiting team and provides you with the opportunity to have a well-informed visit with a health visitor in the near future in Nursery School. We are hoping to host these in the week beginning 21^{st} February, during the children's sessions. Appointment times will be made available as soon as the dates are confirmed.

We would encourage you to make use of these appointments to discuss any concerns regarding your child's development eg. speech & language, sleep patterns/bedtime difficulties, toilet training, how to ditch the dummy, difficult to manage behaviour etc.

In addition, another useful support for these issues is ParentingNI, a charity which offers online podcasts, parenting programmes and workshops, parent guides, support lines (telephone & web chat) and app-based support which can be accessed anonymously if you would prefer.
