

## Report Card 16 Country Highlights – Italy

This report features child well-being outcomes against the backdrop of their country’s policies and social, educational, economic and environmental context.

### League table of child well-being outcomes

The league table of child well-being outcomes shows three dimensions: mental well-being, physical health and skills.

Italy ranks 19<sup>th</sup> in overall child well-being outcomes.

#### *Good mental well-being*

Feeling positive and being in good mental health are key aspects of quality of life. Italy ranks 9<sup>th</sup> in this dimension.

#### *Good physical health*

This includes rates of overweight and obesity, which affect children now and in future, and child mortality. Italy ranks 31<sup>st</sup> in this dimension.

#### *Skills for life*

Learning new skills can be a rewarding experience for children in the present, as well as a foundation for adulthood. Italy ranks 15<sup>th</sup> in this dimension.
