

Sponsorship contract

between

Eurac Research, VAT number 01659400210, represented by its Director Stephan Ortner, registered office in Bolzano 39100, Viale Druso 1, hereafter referred to as "Eurac Research" and

ECOTONE telemetry Lech Iliszko, VAT number PL5851060654, represented by its Legal Representative Lech Iliszko, registered office in Sopot 81871, Słowackiego 12, hereafter referred to as "Sponsor"

Whereas,

- Eurac Research has organised an event called XIV. Italian Congress of Teriology, to be held in Bolzano from 3 to 5 June 2026, and hereafter referred to as event;
- Following the Public notice on the call for economic operators interested in signing financial and/or technical sponsoring contracts published on 12.11.2025, the Sponsor has expressed interest in sponsoring the event for promotional purposes offering the following amount of money: € 1.500,00 VAT Reverse Charge (*gold sponsorship*); - Therefore, the Parties intend to conclude a contract setting out the conditions for the abovementioned sponsorship:

The Parties hereby agree as follows:

1. The preamble constitutes a binding part of the present agreement. The conditions of the abovementioned Public notice (accepted by the Sponsor by participating and expressing interest) and the documents submitted by the Sponsor during the application are hereby considered and included and form part of the present agreement;
2. ECOTONE telemetry Lech Iliszko undertakes to provide support for the event by paying € 1.500,00 VAT Reverse Charge and summing up to a total amount of 1.500,00 € VAT Reverse Charge to Eurac Research, as consideration for the benefits listed below.
3. After signing the present agreement, Eurac Research shall submit an invoice for the described amount, consisting of sponsorship and VAT. The payment will be made within 30 days from receipt of the submitted invoice. Failure to do so allows Eurac Research to terminate the sponsorship due to breach of contract. The payment shall be issued by bank transfer to the following bank account: Banca Popolare dell'Alto Adige, via Leonardo da Vinci, 2, Bolzano (Italy), beneficiary: Accademia Europea di Bolzano (Eurac Research), IBAN: IT69 C058 5611 6010 5057 0009 011, Swift BPAAIT2B050.
4. Eurac Research shall show the Sponsor's logo on the homepage of the website **www.atit2026.it**, the link of which will be available in each one of the posts on the event, also published on the following dissemination channels:
 - A dedicated stand in the main exhibition area to interact directly with participants.
 - Two full access passes for the conference with personalized badges, including access to 5 coffee breaks, a cocktail reception, and a social dinner.
 - Promotional materials (flyers, brochures) included in the conference's goodie bag.
 - Visibility of the Sponsor logo on the badge lanyard, and on the event's websites (including: www.atit2026.it and www.mammiferi.org).

5. The Sponsor shall identify the logo for purpose of the sponsorship and support Eurac Research by any means to ensure the faithful reproduction of the logo.
6. The present agreement shall take effect on the signature date and shall remain effective until the end of the event and, in any case, until the fulfilment of the mutual obligations between the Parties.
7. The unlawfulness of any of the clauses herein does not invalidate the agreement in its entirety. Any changes to this contract shall be agreed on in writing between the Parties.

8. Eurac Research reserves the right to terminate the sponsorship agreement with immediate effect, pursuant to Articles 1456 and 1360 of the Italian Civil Code, without prejudice to its right to claim compensation for any additional damages, in the following circumstances:

- failure by the Sponsor to perform the obligations set out in Art. 2 above, or performance that does not comply with the terms of the sponsorship agreement;
- the occurrence of any adverse event concerning the Sponsor that may, in any way, harm the reputation of Eurac and/or its initiatives, or that is deemed unacceptable on grounds of public order, public interest, or because it contravenes mandatory provisions of law or public decency;
- the emergence or subsequent discovery, after the execution of the agreement, of any conflict of interest.

9. In addition to the cases set by the law, the contract shall also be terminated as of right if the event is cancelled due to the supervenience of norms or orders.

10. The Parties are bound by the provisions arising from the applicable law on personal data protection, especially the EU Regulation 2016/679 and the Legislative Decree 2003/196 and following amendments.

11. ECOTONE telemetry Lech Iliszko acknowledges that it is aware of the provisions of Legislative Decree No. 231/2001 and confirms that it has reviewed the Organisation, Management and Control Model adopted by Eurac Research, including the Code of Conduct, as in force on the date of execution of this agreement, published on the institutional website of Eurac Research, and undertakes to fully comply with its provisions.

ECOTONE telemetry Lech Iliszko is also aware that failure to comply even with a single provision contained in the Code of Conduct constitutes a material breach of the obligations assumed in this contract and constitutes an express termination clause pursuant to Article 1456 of the Italian Civil Code, entitling Eurac Research to terminate the contract with immediate effect, without prejudice to the right to compensation for possible damages.

12. Any legal action or proceeding related to the interpretation or the execution of this contract shall be brought exclusively before the Courts of Bolzano. This contract shall be subject to and construed in accordance with Italian Law.

IN WITNESS whereof the Parties sign this Contract through their duly authorized representatives on the date indicated below. This Contract, drawn up in two copies, shall be signed in handwritten form and shall be exchanged between the parties by post/courier service.
