Approximate dates and gardening activities:

June 1 - Check the irrigation, temperatures are rising.

June 4 - Stay on top of your weeding.

June 5 - Add summer color, vinca is here and loves the heat.

June 8 - Check veggies for harvesting, squash, strawberries, artichokes, blueberries, and early fruit trees.

June 10 - Great selection of supports for your tomato crops. There is still time to get them planted.

June 12 - Fertilize flowers, roses, and veggies to keep them blooming.

June 17 - Warm days and mild nights perfect for planting peppers, melons, okra for the summer.

June 19 - Father's Day - We have great tools, plants, and more just for Dad.

June 20 - Refresh mulch to help conserve moisture. Place bark around flowers & compost around veggies.

June 23 - Overcast mornings-watch for powdery mildew on roses, begonias, and euonymus.

June 25 - Dead head roses and other flowers.

June 26 - Keep an eye out for destructive bugs: aphids, thrips, and use Insecticidal Soap.

June 29 - Remove standing water from the garden to reduce Mosquitos.

June 30 - Use Soil Moist in pots to help reduce water.
