July Gardening Calendar

Approximate dates and gardening activities:

- July 1 - If it's not too hot, you can fertilize for summer blooms.
- July 4 - Check out our blogs for fun recipes for your 4th of July holiday.
- July 8 - Double check that all irrigation is working properly. Earwigs like to hide in emitters and 1/4" tubing to keep cool and for moisture.
- July 10 - Check your watering schedule. Timing is important – Plants like deep soaks less often. And be sure to water in the early morning to conserve water.
- July 22 - With warmer weather we are seeing more Thrips on roses – use Captain Jack's Deadbug Brew.
- July 23 - Start checking for fruit and don't let your zucchini fruit get too big before picking, 6 to 8" is good.
- July 29 - Dead head any spent flowers to keep the blooms coming.
