Approximate dates and gardening activities:

- Dec. 8 – Clear your gutters of leaves and debris
- Dec. 9 – Don't forget to feed the birds. All the seeds from your garden are gone so help a feathered friends out
- Dec. 10 – Last chance this season to plant a beautiful spring with Spring Flowering Bulbs
- Dec. 11 – It's a great time to plant winter veggies and plan your spring garden with seeds
- Dec. 13 – Watch for Slugs and Snails. Bait them with Sluggo or Sluggo Plus
- Dec. 15 – Reduce or turn off your irrigation system if it's raining
- Dec. 17 – Bareroot roses have arrived, and we have some beautiful new varieties you won't want to miss
