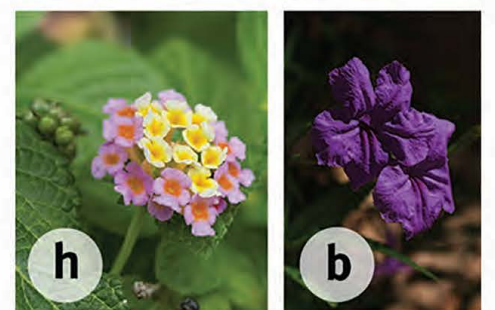

- **Aloe Ferox (a) (aka Cape Aloe, Bitter Aloe, Red Aloe & Tap Aloe)** – this evergreen succulent enjoys full sun and well-drained soil. Drought tolerant and needs only occasional watering once established. Wonderful accent plant for borders, in garden beds or in containers.
- **Baja Ruellia (b) *Ruellia peninsularis*** – This evergreen shrub produces masses of dense, deep blue-purple petunia-like flowers. Enjoys partial to full sun and needs only occasional watering once established.
- **Bird of Paradise (red/yellow) (c) *Strelitzia reginae*** – This tropical-looking evergreen produces large, bird-like colorful flower heads and enjoys partial to full sun. Grows best with regular watering—weekly, or more often in extreme heat. Fabulous as a border, in containers, poolside or in an urban garden.
- **Claret-cup Cactus (d) *Echinocereus triglochidiatus*** – Gorgeous bright scarlet-red to orange-red blooms adorn this cactus spring through early summer. Enjoys full sun and well-drained soil. Ideal for desert gardens, rock gardens, succulent gardens, Mediterranean gardens and in containers. Deer and rabbit resistant.
- **Coral Bells (e) *Heuchera*** – This beautiful plant enjoys partial shade to full sun and blooms spring through fall. Different coral bell varieties offer a wide range of dramatic foliage colors. Wonderful as a border, in a container, in mass plantings or in rock gardens.
- **Eremophila (f) (aka Emu Bush)** – This waterwise, desert-loving evergreen shrub enjoys full sun and colorful blooms in spring. Requires only occasional watering, once established.
- **Impatiens (g)** – Vibrant blooms from spring to late summer. Enjoys full shade to partial sun and moist soil by frequent watering. Great as a border, in a patio container or hanging basket, as a mass planting or even poolside.
- **Lantana (h) *Shrub verbenas*** – This firewise, prolific flower blooms spring through summer and enjoys full sun. Once established it needs only occasional watering. Landscapes uses include as a border, in containers, as a mass planting.
- **Petunias (i)** – Petunias enjoy full sun and offer high-impact color from late spring until the first frost. Ideal for containers, hanging baskets or as seasonal borders.
- **Pomegranate (j) *Punica granatum*** – Orange-red blooms produce large vivid red fruit. Enjoys full sun and needs only occasional watering once established; water more while blooming/producing fruit.
- **Salvia species (various) (k)** – These waterwise, drought tolerant plants enjoy full sun and bloom spring into summer. Needs only occasional watering once established.
- **Trumpet Vine (l) *Campsis radicans*** – This vine enjoys partial shade to full sun and blooms in the summer. Grows best with the support of a trellis, fence or arbor. Excellent as an accent plant. Water regularly in extreme heat; once established, requires little water and care.
- **Yellow Bells (m) *Tecoma stans*** – Fast growing with beautiful large clusters of bell-shaped flowers that bloom golden-yellow. This semi-evergreen is very heat tolerant and grows best in full sun.
- **Yucca (n)** – Low maintenance, drought resistant and waterwise. This evergreen grows best in full sun, flowers in the summertime and is a great choice for the poolside, containers and Firescaping.
