### LOCAL GIN

#### **Great Glen £9.50 ABV 43%**

##### **Raspberry, Hibiscus, Rose & Apple**

*Produced on the banks of Loch Ness using the local water. This gin balances classic pine notes of juniper and citrusy coriander.*

#### **Great Glen Pink £9.50 ABV 43%**

*Classic pine notes of juniper and citrusy coriander seeds are elevated by distilled Scottish raspberries, vapour infused rose & hibiscus petals and sweet Pink Lady apples to produce this Loch Ness based gin.*

#### **Kinrara Highland Dry £9.00 ABV 41.5%**

*Cairngorm National Park gin made with a blend of locally sourced of foraged botanicals. The selection of botanicals includes rowan berries and rosehips.*

#### **Kinrara Hibiscus £9.00 ABV 40%**

*A gin made with locally sourced botanicals from the Cairngorm mountains including rosehips and rowan berries. The gin is then cold compounded with additional Hibiscus flowers and sweet orange peel to provide a luxurious deep pink hue and distinct floral flavour.*

#### **Loch Achall Gin £8.00 ABV 38%**

*Loch Achall Gin is a complex blend including gorse flower, rowan berries and heather along with crisp water from Rhidorroch distillery situated in Ullapool. This ensures a distinctive flavour with floral notes and a hint of citrus.*

#### **Red Door £8.20 ABV 45%**

*Made in the fabulous Benromach distillery, Red Door Gin is a small-batch, handcrafted London Dry style gin. Sharp citrus cuts through bright juniper and floral heather. A bitter herbal note lingers underneath with touches of honey and chocolate.*

### **Blackwoods £5.50 ABV 40%**

*Top-quality gin made using botanicals from Shetland.*

*Warming cassia and black pepper, savoury thyme, floral vanilla, a touch of lemon zest.*

### **Boë Violet £9.20 ABV 41.5%**

*The addition of violets creates a stylish gin with a light, delicate taste and beautiful colour and aroma.*

### **The Botanist £6.60 ABV 46%**

*Bruichladdich's Botanist gin boasts a bountiful bunch of botanicals. 31, to be precise, including 22 native to the Isle of Islay.*

### **Caorunn £6.00 ABV 41.8%**

*At first, floral then notes of heather and citrus blossom with Juniper coming through later.*

### **Eden Mill Love £8.00 ABV 42%**

*Juniper with hints of raspberries and rose.*

### **Edinburgh Raspberry £5.60 ABV 20%**

*A tasty Raspberry-flavoured gin liqueur made using an infusion of Scottish raspberries.*

### **Edinburgh Rhubarb & Ginger £5.60 ABV 20%**

*A tasty Rhubarb & Ginger flavoured gin liqueur made using an infusion of pure rhubarb and ginger.*

### **Hendrick's £5.60 ABV 41.4%**

*It features the likes of juniper, cubeb berries, elderflower, chamomile, angelica, lemon peel, orange peel, coriander, yarrow and orris, alongside an infusion of cucumber and rose petal.*

### **Vesperis Pictish Gin £8.50 ABV 40%**

*A smooth balanced gin, with the profile of heather mead.*



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## GIN

### **Aviation American £6.00 ABV 42%**

*Referred to as an "American dry gin", meaning the taste profile is less strongly juniper flavoured than some other gins. a blend of Juniper, Cardamom, French Lavender, Indian Sarsaparilla, Coriander, Anise seed and two kinds of orange peel.*

### **Bathtub Gin £8.00 ABV 43.3%**

*A uniquely characterful gin, full of fresh botanical flavours Bathtub Gin is double infused for extra flavour. The initial focus is juniper, but the earthier botanicals make themselves known in the initial palate too.*

### **Beefeater £4.50 ABV 40%**

*Strong juniper and complexity and earthiness, with darker citrus, coriander and licorice notes.*

### **Beefeater Pink £4.50 ABV 37.5%**

*Summer berry notes after an earthy and aromatic lead.*

### **Bloom £7.00 ABV 40%**

*Named "Bloom" in reference to the floral nature of its botanicals: honeysuckle, pomelo and chamomile.*

### **Bombay Sapphire £5.50 ABV 40%**

*The flavouring of the drink comes from a recipe of ten ingredients. Light and piney juniper, with soft peppery warmth building. Subtle sweetness of sugared almond and angelica develops, still packed with herbaceous-ness.*

### **Brockmans Intensely Smooth £9.10 ABV 40%**

*Tuscan juniper berries, Bulgarian coriander, blueberries, blackberries and bittersweet Valencian orange peel steeped in grain spirit.*

### **.Gordons £4.50 ABV 37.5%**

*Sweet notes of juniper, a touch of lemon zest, sweetness and a hint of fresh herbs.*



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**Monkey 47 £8.30 ABV 47%**

*An unusual gin from the Black Forest in Germany, Monkey 47 contains a unique ingredient, Lingonberries. Predictably complex, this is a robust and powerful gin with plenty of spice, fruit and herb flavours. It's very well structured, and difficult to unpick but a citrus fresh start segues into pine and wood notes for a drying finish*

**Ophir Oriental Spiced Gin £5.60 ABV 40%**

*It's incredibly spicy on the nose, which is intense with cardamom and ginger, with notes of toasted cumin seed and curry powder underneath.*

**Tanqueray £5.50 ABV 43.1%**

*This gin boasts a phenomenally fruity, spicy palate with big zesty, citrusy top notes which make it the perfect all-rounder.*

**Tanqueray Flor De Sevilla £6.00 ABV 41.3%**

*In early 2018, they released Tanqueray Sevilla Gin, inspired by the recipe written over 140 years ago, by creator Charles Tanqueray. Crisp juniper and zesty orange flesh, supported by earthy vanilla and allspice.*

**Warner's Elderflower £7.25 ABV 40%**

*Here we have Warner's Elderflower Gin, infused with elderflowers from the local hedgerows surrounding the distillery. The elderflowers are handpicked and only harvested once a year, with around 300 in each bottle!*

**Whitley Neill Raspberry £5.60 ABV 43%**

*Launched right at the start of 2018, featuring Scottish raspberries at its core alongside punchy notes of liquorice and coriander in support.*

**Whitley Neill Rhubarb and Ginger £5.60**

**ABV 43%**

*The essence of rhubarb adds a tart crisp edge to a smooth English gin base whilst the ginger extract warms the palate for a full-bodied finish.*

**Tomatin Legacy, Tomatin 14, Cu Bocan Signature**

Tomatin Distillery was established in 1897, situated just 12 miles South of The Drumossie Hotel. Here we bring you a selection of some of our favourite "Local Lads".

Time in Bourbon barrels and Virgin Oak casks brings a light sweetness to The Tomatin Legacy, a non-peaty scotch which boasts aromas of vanilla bean, white chocolate, and cinnamon.

On the palate gentle waves of fresh fruit peppered with ginger emerge ahead of a light, clean finish.

The 14-year-old single malt whisky is matured in a combination of Bourbon barrels and Port casks. It is soft, smooth, and sweet, benefiting from its time spent in Tawny Port casks which previously held port for around 50 years. Rich but balanced aromas of red berries, sweet honey and rich toffee develop into aspects of light fruits and nuts on the palate and an abiding finish of smooth fruit salad.

Cu Bocan Signature aged in Bourbon, Oloroso Sherry & North American Virgin Oak Casks. Smoke intertwines with rich citrus and exotic spices. Subtly smoky, surprisingly sweet, it opens up the world of lightly peated whisky.



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### **A Stroll Down The River £22.50**

#### **Glenlivet 12, Cragganmore 12, Balvenie Doublewood**

*A selection of Speyside single malts*

A Speyside whisky is one that has been produced in the area known as Speyside, a subdivision of the Highland region, defined simply as a whisky that's made in the Strathspey area; "strath" meaning "near".

At Drumossie we love to savour these Smooth Spey's, here are some of the teams favourites.-

Balvenie Doublewood, Firstly matured in refill American oak casks then finished in first fill European oak Oloroso sherry butts for an additional nine months, this rich and complex dram is an excellent example of what the Balvenie distillery offers

Cragganmore distillery is situated in the village of Ballindalloch. The distillery was founded in 1869. The site was chosen by founder, Smith both for its proximity to the waters of the Craggan burn and because it was close to the Strathspey Railway.

Smith was an experienced distiller, having already been manager of the Macallan, Glenlivet, Glenfarclas and Wishaw distilleries. Cragganmore 12 is rich and spicy, with a very satisfying complexity and well-sherried backbone.

One of the most famous malts in the world. Glenlivet 12 has a soft smooth balance of sweet summer fruits and the floral notes of spring flowers. Matured in European and American Oak. With apricot, pineapple, greengages, citrus blossom and toasted teacake. On the nose and Buttery and vanilla-rich, on the pallet this one is a treat.



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### **North Coast 500 £27.50**

#### **Old Pulteney 12, Glen Ord Singleton, Dalmore 12**

*A variety of single malts from the breathtaking North Coast 500 Route.*

Dalmore 12 wont disappoint, this dark outstanding single malt matured in American white oak ex-bourbon casks and finessed in rare and aged oloroso sherry casks. With Seville oranges, dried fruits and hints of vanilla pod on the pallet, and the aroma of Citrus fruits, chocolate and aromatic spices we think this is class.

Old Pulteney hails from Wick, right at the top of the NC500 route. And from this (almost) most Northerly distillery comes Old Pulteney 12. Dry medium bodied and smooth, faintly salty with a slight spice.

Finishing your journey back in near Inverness, with the Glen Ord Singleton 12 year old single malt scotch whisky which is matured in a high proportion of American oak casks with a small portion of European oak casks to balance the liquid. The result is an easy to enjoy single malt with notes of luscious brown sugar, soft cooked apples and creamy toffee, best served with laughter and good company.



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### **Peaty Islands £22.00**

**Talisker 10, Laphroaig 10, Ardbeg 10**

*Delightfully peated, these are strong but beautiful Island & Islay single malts.*

Out on the shores on Skye you will find Talisker, the 10 year old is where this flight begins, where rugged coastlines meet the raging sea, you find adventure in a bottle. Talisker single malt scotch whisky captures the elemental wildness and unadulterated beauty of its birthplace. A fresh and fragrant nose then smoke comes with sweet pear and apple peel, with pinches of salt & seaweed. The palate is a bonfire of peat crackling with black pepper, with a touch of brine and dry barley. A welcome delivery of orchard fruit provides a delicate and beautiful balance.

Move on to the richer Laphroaig 10... once you get to know this peaty personality, it's impossible not to love it. Its character is rooted in its island home and unique house process, which infuses Laphroaig with signature smokiness, 'medicinal' maritime notes and a surprising sweetness.

Finish this tour of peat and smoke with Ardbeg 10  
For over 200 years, Ardbeg has been made on the small, remote Scottish Isle of Islay.

This one is an explosion of crackling peat sets off millions of flavour explosions, the nose -  
A ridge of vanilla leads to mountain of peat capped with citrus fruits and circled by clouds of sea spray, whilst on the pallet Sweet vanilla counterbalanced with lemon and lime followed by that surging Ardbeg smoke.



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### **Through The Years £30.00**

**Glenfiddich 12, 15 & 18**

*A great way to try single malts of varying ages from one distillery.*

William Grant's passion, determination and pioneering spirit continues to guide the Glenfiddich team to this day. This is one of the few single malt distilleries to remain entirely family owned. Their Scotch Whisky is a true reflection of the founder's innovative nature, passed down through the generations.

Begin with Glenfiddich 12 on the nose you will get grain, a slightly floral, mineralic note, then orchard fruit and malty, honey, After citrus develops. On the palate, Light, floral, spices. Very smooth.

Follow on with Glenfiddich 15 Solera where Sherry and citrus - orange in particular, and dry wood entice you, don't miss the slight suggestion of smoke. Before a palate of raisins, Fruitcake, spices and sweetness.

Glenfiddich 18 Ancient Reserve will give you an exceptional finish to this flight. This has a nose filled with fruit, especially Zesty grapefruit and baked toffee apples. Then dry,- chocolate Flaked wood and cinnamon. The palate: Candied fruits and the classic Glenfiddich freshness balances richer notes of dried apricot, more cinnamon and toffee, ginger and dry Sherry.



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## Highland Single Malts

### **Brora 30 year old £315.00 ABV 53.2%**

*(2009 8th annual release 1 of only 2652 bottles)*

*Nose: The classic non peaty Brora, with hint of sherry sweetness. Some sharp citrusy, and a little grassy and minty. Some rocks and mineral as well.*

*Palate: Oily and waxy, with quite fresh fruits. Some salted pepper, lemons, a little sweetness, some herbal notes as well. Salty then more lemons after a sip, and the saltiness faded after a while. Clean and crisp.*

### **Dalmore 12 year old £7.75 ABV 40%**

*Nose: Roasting beans, the oily nuttiness in an espresso, there are notes of malt and cereal and butter like a patisserie with rich orange too.*

*Palate: Notes of Seville marmalade and triple sec with winter spices and fruitcake. Zesty cocoa and milk chocolate.*

### **Dalwhinnie 15 year old £9.25 ABV 43%**

*Nose: Aromatic, toffee, fruit salad, lush nectarine, custard. Floral, apple blossom, honeysuckle.  
Apple peel, pear, touch of smoke.*

*Palate: Malty. Walnuts steeped in manuka honey with vanilla sponge. Gentle smoke weaves its way through the cereal with a touch of spice.*

### **Clynelish 14 year old £12.75 ABV 46%**

*Nose: Zesty, mandarin, tangerine with smoky notes*

*Palate: Quite light, great clarity. Slight citrus hints on a honey background with peat and delicious spices before a honey finish and a touch of vanilla.*

### **The Singleton Glen Ord 15 year old £9.25**

**ABV 40%**

*Nose: A cautious start with soft hints of melon and summer citrus fruit, opening up to reveal firm wax notes and rich floral aromas.*

*Palate: Gently coating. At first, layers of ripe melon fruit and zesty orange-oil freshness fuse with sultanas and spiced biscuits.*



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### **Glengoyne 10 year old £7.50 ABV 40%**

*Nose: Slightly herbal, big bourbon influence which has brought a wonderful "high note". White milk bottle sweets, more creamy than fruity.*

*Palate: Barley rich, more bourbon influence. Clean and dry.*

### **Glenmorangie 10 year old £7.00 ABV 40%**

*Nose: Very fruity and thick. Rich notes of lemon, nectarine and apple. Spices.*

*Palate: Fresh and balanced, vanilla. Boiled sweets, very creamy, tiramisu, toffee.*

### **Glenmorangie Lasanta**

#### **12 year old £9.50 ABV 43%**

*Nose: Plum and baking spice supported by milk chocolate raisin, caramel and toasty oak.*

*Palate: A dash of tart raspberry coulis leads into a generous helping of sherried dried fruit, with orange marmalade, toasted nuts and berry jam. Sweeter notes of brown sugar and cereal notes appear.*

### **Glenmorangie Quinta Ruban**

#### **14 year old £10.25 ABV 46%**

*Nose: Dark mint chocolate, tangerines and Seville oranges mingle with sandalwood and walnut before giving way to a spicy finish of pepper and nutmeg.*

*Palate: Mint chocolate and walnuts envelop the palate like velvet, laying the foundations for rose, Turkish delight and sweet Seville oranges.*





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**Glenmorangie Signet £34.00 ABV 46%**

*Nose: The nose begins with chocolate raisins and sugared mixed peels. Toasted spices, bread and butter pudding and golden syrup complement these aromas, while a note of Angostura bitters lingers beneath.*

*Palate: Sweet, syrupy cinnamon and drying malt lead, before a suggestion of Terry's Chocolate Orange rises. A hint of lime rind is present, as are lychees and dates. The backdrop is filled with tobacco leaves and freshly roasted espresso beans, with a little honey-roasted cashew.*

**Glenugie 1977 32 year old Deoch an Doras  
£150.00 ABV 55.48%**

*Nose: Black soil, used leather with glass-filling spices led by cloves. Pu'er tea leaves, dried red dates, red bean mash and some Jiayingzi preserved plums. It turned to red apples after spending some time in the glass. The spices-focused sherry turned more friendlier after a sip and showed a touch of red apple peel.*

*Palate: Preserved plums, red apples, dark plums with skin, assorted spices plus black pepper and finally some dark chocolate. The second sip was better than the first.*

**Oban 14 year old £9.50 ABV 43%**

*Nose: Rich sweetness and fruits - oranges, lemons and pears, with sea-salt and peaty smokiness.*

*Body: Full, rich.*

*Palate: Mouth-filling late autumn fruits - dried figs and honey-sweet spices; followed by a smoky malty dryness.*

**Tomatin Legacy £8.00 ABV 43%**

*Nose: Lemon, panatella and pine forest. Slightly green with vanilla.*

*Palate: Cracked pepper and sweet barley with pineapple cube sweets. Waves of warming oak beneath.*



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**Speyside Single Malts**

**Balvenie 12 year old Doublewood £8.25  
ABV 40%**

*Nose: Grainy, supple nuttiness intertwined with spices. Honeyed sultanas and grapes. Hugely inviting.*

*Palate: Sweet with good body. The bourbon characters develop; gentle spice with a little vanilla, a hint of balancing peat lurking quietly in the substrata.*

*Dried fruit too, combining with nuts, nutmeg, cinnamon.*

**Cragganmore 12 year old £8.00 ABV 40%**

*Nose: Aromatic, floral. Heather, fruit salad, creamy texture. Smoked almonds, hay.*

*Palate: Rich, honey, stone fruits, chestnuts, walnuts, almonds, Berries.*

**Glenfiddich 12 year old £7.75 ABV 40%**

*Nose: Grain. Slightly floral, mineralic. Spirity, orchard fruit, malty, honey. Citrus develops.*

*Palate: Light, floral, spices. Very smooth.*

**Glenfiddich 15 year old Solera £9.25 ABV 40**

*Nose: Sherry, citrus - orange in particular, dry wood. Slight suggestion of smoke.*

*Palate: Medium, Sherry, raisins. Fruitcake, spices, sweetness.*



### **Glenfiddich 18 year old Ancient Reserve**

**£14.50 ABV 40%**

*Nose: Loads of fruit. Zesty grapefruit, baked toffee apples. Dry, chocolate Flaked wood and cinnamon.*

*Palate: Candied fruits and Glenfiddich freshness balances richer notes of dried apricot, more cinnamon and toffee, ginger and dry Sherry.*

### **Glenlivet Founders Reserve £7.00 ABV 40**

*Nose: Some dates then slightly sharp plum and apricot wine note. There's orange zest, toffee, hints of struck match and chocolate raisins, but before this starts to sound 'Sherried' there's also pear drops, a dusting of sweet cinnamon, honeysuckle and sweet pea.*

*Palate: Fruity, then sweet, more toffee, a touch of anise, then into milk chocolate Flakes, banoffee pie and apple turnovers.*

### **Glenlivet 12 year old £8.25 ABV 40%**

*Nose: Apricot, pineapple, greengages, citrus blossom and toasted teacake.*

*Palate: Buttery and vanilla-rich, though still packing all the bright fruit notes from the nose.*



## **Lowland Malts**

### **Auchentoshan 12 year old £8.00 ABV 40%**

*Nose: A cereal-sweet nose with notes of guava and mango, with a drizzle of honey.*

*Palate: Oaky and sweet palate, with barley sugar, a little passion fruit and vanilla custard too. Perhaps some rose petal jelly in there.*

### **Auchentoshan Three Wood £9.00 ABV 43%**

*Nose: Blackcurrants, brown sugar, oranges, plums and raisins.*

*Palate: Fruit syrup, plums and raisins intense, sweet and complex.*

### **Glenkinchie 12 year old £8.70 ABV 43%**

*Nose: A light, aromatic nose with hints of barley malt, almonds, hazelnuts and manuka honey/beeswax.*

*Palate: Very fruity palate with a mix of stewed fruits, dessert wine, apple peel and honey. Becomes quite oaky late palate.*

### **St Magdalene 26 year old £160.00 ABV 50% (Old Malt Cask Bottling 2008 1 of only 511 bottles)**

*Nose: Very fruity with limes, oranges, apple tart with custard.*

*Palate: Mixed peels, cocoa, good sweetness, very fruity, great richness.*





## Islay Malts

### **Ardbeg Uigeadail £12.50 ABV 54.2%**

*Nose: Multifaceted, notes of peat and little flourishes of dark sugar, freshly ground espresso beans, cereal notes, and a most sophisticated tar.*

*Palate: Led by sweet, ripe fruit and black forest honey. A good helping of malt. The throne then usurped by a powerful peat and smoked barley*

### **Bowmore 18 year old £21.00 ABV 43%**

*Nose: Pungent, citrus. Stewing fruit, hints of damp wood and a very soft smoke.*

*Palate: Spirit tones at first, then gives way to fruit, plum jam and perfume. A good sweetness, peat smoke, grapey.*

### **Bruichladdich The Classic Laddie**

#### **Scottish Barley £7.50 ABV 50%**

*Nose: Elegantly sweet with honeyed barley, boiled sweets and orange petals. Wafts of sea air.*

*Palate: Red apples and white grapes, with touches of sweet cinnamon and brown sugar. Still softly coastal.*



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### **Lagavulin 16 year old £18.00 ABV 43%**

*Nose: One of the smokiest noses from Islay. A concentrated, and redolent of iodine, sweet spices, good, mature Sherry, and creamy vanilla.*

*Palate: Very thick and rich. A massive mouthful of malt and Sherry with good fruity sweetness, but also a wonderful sweetness. Big, dominant peat and oak.*

### **Laphroaig 10 year old £7.50 ABV 40%**

*Nose: This opens on big, smoky muscular peat notes. There are spices, and liquorice, as well as a big dose of salt.*

*Palate: Seaweed-led, with a hint of vanilla ice cream and more than a whiff of notes of TCP. An upsurge of spices develop cardamom/black pepper/chilli.*

## Island Malts

### **Highland Park 12 year old £7.75 ABV 40%**

*Nose: Fresh, clean and very aromatic. Floral notes abound the senses with a light grassiness. Notes of creamy Manuka honey and a touch of juicy citrus with cream and a well-balanced sweetness.*

*Palate: Rather full with a pleasant depth. Lurking somewhere in the substratum a grilled orange lies. Notes of granary toast and green tea with jasmine. A touch of sweetness.*

### **Jura 10 year old £7.50 ABV 40%**

*Nose: Honeyed barley and peaches in syrup, with light wafts of fragrant wood smoke.*

*Palate: Oily and subtly spicy at first, before notes of earthy vanilla pod and chocolate-covered raisins develop.*

### **Talisker 10 year old £7.50 ABV 45.8%**

*Nose: A fresh and fragrant nose. Through thick, pungent smoke comes sweet pear and apple peel, with pinches of maritime salt from kippers, seaweed.*

*Palate: It's a bonfire of peat crackling with black pepper, with a touch of brine and dry barley. A welcome delivery of orchard fruit provides a delicate and beautiful balance.*



## Blends, Blended Malts and Grain

### **Chivas Regal 12 year old £6.00 ABV 40%**

*Nose: A creamy, aromatic melange of vanilla custard, hints of aniseed, lemon curd and butter toffee. Wood shavings and dried banana chips develop with just a hint of cassis.*

*Palate: More of those banana chips showing through on the palate, this time there's a creamy hit of barley malt too, pepped up with a little allspice. Notes of ground walnut and caramel.*

### **Chivas Regal 18 Year old £8.25 ABV 40%**

*Nose: Balanced. Orange peel, malted barley. Vanilla fudge, touch of spice.*

*Palate: Medium body, marmalade, dark chocolate, touch of wood.*

### **The Famous Grouse £4.50 ABV 40%**

*Nose: Light, crisp. Cut flowers. Barley. Toffee sweetness.*

*Palate: Light and balanced. Spice, barley. Caramel, touch of smoke.*

### **Grants £4.50 ABV 40%**

*Nose: quite soft and light. There are notes of malted barley and toasted cereals with the requisite sweetness.*

*Palate: of good body and quite sweet. There are notes of toffee and caramel with vanilla fudge and a touch of gentle, supple oak.*

### **Monkey Shoulder Blended Malt £6.25 ABV 40%**

*Nose: An elegant, stylish nose of marmalade, Crema Catalana, cocoa and malt. Plenty of vanilla and a sprinkling of winter spice (nutmeg, cloves and cinnamon) alongside a mouth-watering hint of aniseed.*

*Palate: Very malty, creamy delivery with a suggestion of berry fruit. Juicy toasted barley, cloves and butterscotch. Manuka honey, hot-buttered-toast and dried apricot develop.*



## Irish Blended Whiskey

### **Jameson £5.00 ABV 40%**
