### FISH & CHIPS IN CULTURE

First sold by Malin's in East London in 1860, fish and chips quickly became a national treasure. During WWII, they were one of the few foods not rationed in the UK, earning high praise as "the good companions" by Winston Churchill.



#### POTATOES
