Present continuous	My dad is washing the car.	The car is being washed by my dad.
Past simple	Shakespeare wrote Hamlet.	Hamlet was written by Shakespeare.
Past continuous	She was cleaning the house.	The house was being cleaned.
Present perfect	They have opened a new shop.	A new shop has been opened.
Past perfect	They had stolen a computer.	A computer had been stolen.
Future simple	Tom will cut the grass.	The grass will be cut by Tom.
Present conditional	I would buy that house.	That house would be bought by me.
Modals	We must eat that meat soon. They can borrow our books.	That meat must be eaten soon. Our books can be borrowed by them.
