What you will be doing

You will:

- connect with other developers and publish content online, though social media, (blogs, articles, webinars, videos, tutorials), relevant forums, across related communities and in person at global conferences, hackathons, meetups, coding boot camps and other appropriate channels.
- write sample code and apps, develop prototypes, author client libraries, and work with MATTRs partners and customers
- contribute to open source and evolving standards
- obsess over onboarding experience. You will proactively connect with both individual developers experimenting with our platform as well enterprise customers. You will seek to understand and remove any blockers, provide advice and guidance and assist with onboarding to the platform
- advocate for technology and software adoption and best practices in a manner that non-technical people can understand, understanding a variety of different use cases and how our technology can add business value to various industry verticals
- gather insights about our products from the developer community and channel this information back to product and engineering teams.
- keep track of industry trends and develop a strong understanding of competitive products

What are the skills and requirements needed?

You will:

- Have a full stack developer background with a broad understanding of many languages and framework including Typescript, React Native, Go, Rust.
- Be able to roll up your sleeves and produce prototypes, sample apps etc.
- Have excellent communications and written skills and must be able to talk about technology intelligently and passionately to all levels of an organisation including Developers, Architects and senior management (technical and non-technical).
- Have excellent presentation skills. You're able to develop audience-appropriate content and demonstrations for both small and large audiences.
- Have experience with public speaking, presentations, podcasts, webinars, blog and article writing
- Love creating video content, walkthroughs and other useful collateral for developers.
- Have very strong facilitation and moderation skills often hosting workshops that drive to tangible outcomes.
- Have a strong network of like minded individuals and the skills and ability to continue to build the network with strong and enduring relationships.
- Have a strong understanding of security, reliability, scalability and platform management topics.
- Be flexible with regards to work schedule and travel. You're comfortable working to overseas time zones.
- Likely have previous start-up and developer evangelism or develop advocate experience and working in open source / developer communities.
- Have strong organisational skills. These are critical as you will have a lot of balls in the air at any one time.
