THE MEADOW ACCESSIBLE CAMPING

Located near Whistlers Green and the campervan fields at the south end of site. Closest entrance gate is South Gate. The Meadow campsite is managed by GAMA CIC between 11am – 6pm Thurs, Fri, Sat, Sun. If you have specific or complex access needs, please contact access@boomtownfair.co.uk so The Meadow team can assess how best to facilitate your stay.

- **Town Centre**
- **Bang Hai**
- **The Windmill**
- **Sector 6 - viewing area**

Platforms are stewarded and have wheelchair charging facilities and seating.

MEDICAL AND WELFARE

Look for this symbol on the Access Map.

The main medical hospital and welfare centre is situated in Hilltop, near to Town Centre. Open 24hrs from Thurs 9th Aug at 7am – 10pm Mon 13th Aug.

A second, smaller medical and welfare centre is situated in Downtown, next to the information point. Open 24hrs from Thurs 9th Aug at 7am – 10pm Mon 13th Aug.

A satellite medical post will be open from 12pm Wed 8th Aug for the Wednesday opening area.

ARRIVING BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT

There is a wheelchair accessible shuttle service between the Public Transport Hub at West Gate, to South Gate, which is closest to The Meadow.
