

#### **REVIEW REPORT**

#### Introduction

We have reviewed the accompanying condensed consolidated financial statements for the 6 month period ending 30 June 2007 of PPF Group N.V., which comprises the balance sheet as at 30 June 2007, the profit and loss account, the statement of changes in equity, the cash flow statement and the notes. Management is responsible for the preparation and presentation of this interim financial information in accordance with IAS 34, 'Interim Financial Reporting', as adopted by the EU. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on this interim financial information based on our review.

#### Scope of Review

We conducted our review in accordance with Dutch law including standard 2410 "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity". A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with auditing standards and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

#### Conclusion

Based on our review, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying condensed consolidated financial statements as at 30 June 2007 are not prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with IAS 34, 'Interim Financial Reporting', as adopted by the EU.

# NOTES TO THE CONDENSED CONSOLIDATED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

### A. General

#### A.1. Description of the Group

PPF Group N.V. ("the Parent Company") is a company domiciled in the Netherlands. The condensed consolidated financial statements of the Parent Company as at and for the six months ended 30 June 2007 comprise the Parent Company and its subsidiaries (together referred to as the "Group") and the Group's interest in associates, joint ventures and affiliated entities.

See section C of these financial statements for a listing of significant Group enterprises and changes to the Group in 2007.

#### A.3. Basis of preparation

The Dutch accounting legislation enables the Group to prepare these consolidated financial statements in accordance with IFRS (as adopted by EU).

The financial statements are presented in Czech Crowns ("CZK"), rounded to the nearest million.

The financial statements have been prepared on a historic cost basis, except for the following assets and liabilities which are stated at their fair value: derivative financial instruments, financial instruments held for trading, financial instruments designated upon initial recognition as valued at fair value through profit and loss, financial instruments classified as available-for-sale and investment properties. Financial assets and liabilities and non-financial assets and liabilities which are valued at historic cost are stated at amortised cost or historic cost, as appropriate, net of any relevant impairment.

Non-current assets and disposal groups held for sale are stated at the lower of carrying amount and fair value less costs to sell.

The preparation of the financial statements in accordance with IFRS requires management to make judgments, estimates and assumptions that affect the application of policies and the reported amounts of assets and liabilities, income and expenses. The estimates and associated assumptions are based on historic experience and various other factors that are believed to be reasonable under the circumstances, the results of which form the basis of the judgments about the carrying values of assets and liabilities that cannot readily be determined from other sources. The actual values may differ from these estimates.

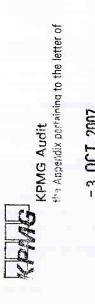

#### C.3. Assets and liabilities held for sale and discontinued operations

On 10 July 2007 PPF Group and Generali Group signed a contract for the Generali PPF Holding joint venture. Generali and PPF Group will transfer their insurance assets in Central and Eastern Europe to the new venture. The whole transaction is subject to several approvals of antimonopoly and financial services authorities which may affect the timing and occurrence of the transaction steps.

The Parent Company has established a new holding company PPF Co1 B.V. CZIH Holdings N.V. and all its subsidiaries (CZIH Group) will be transferred from the Parent Company to PPF Co1 B.V. (expected in October 2007).

Additionally, PPF Co1 B.V. has established (together with Generali Group) a new holding company Generali PPF Holding B.V. which shall play a role of the joint venture company. The whole CZIH Group and selected investments from Generali Group will be contributed to Generali PPF Holding B.V. The contract values the whole CZIH Group transferred by PPF Group at EUR 3,6 billion and investments transferred by Generali Group at EUR 1,5 billion. As a result of PPF group's and Generali's contributions, PPF Group N.V. will keep 71 % ownership interest in Generali PPF Holding B.V.

Simultaneously, PPF Co1 B.V. will sell 22 % ownership in Generali PPF Holding B.V. for EUR 1,1, billion. The final phase of the transaction is that PPF Co1 B.V. keeps finally 49 % ownership interest in Generali PPF Holding B.V. and does not control Generali PPF Holding B.V. PPF Group will invest money obtained from selling 22% ownership in Generali PPF Holding B.V. in the further development of consumer finance business.

The whole transaction is from the Parent Company's point of view regarded as an exchange of 100 % ownership interest in CZIH Group for 49 % ownership interest in Generali PPF Holding B.V.

The closing of the transaction including all three steps described above is expected to occur in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2007 or in 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2008.

After this transaction PPF Group does not control any other companies providing insurance business, CZIH Group ceases to be consolidated by the full method of consolidation and starts to be consolidated by using the equity method.

Insurance segment represents a separate major line of business, it meets the definition of discontinued operations and during 2007 until the disposal it meets the definition of Non-current assets held for sale.

# D. Significant accounting policies and assumptions

#### D.1. Significant accounting policies

The Group applies the same accounting policies in these condensed consolidated financial statements as were applied in the recent annual consolidated financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2006, except for the changes described below.

Since November 2006 the Group has changed prospectively the policy regarding classification of non-trading debt securities. Group companies providing insurance business designate non-trading debt securities primarily as financial assets available for sale.

# D.2. Changes in accounting policies and accounting pronouncements adopted since 1 January 2007

The following published amendments and interpretations to existing standards are mandatory and relevant for the Group's accounting periods and have been applied by the Group since 1 January 2007:

IFRS 7, Financial Instruments: Disclosures, and a complementary amendment to IAS 1, Presentation of Financial Statements – Capital Disclosures (effective from 1 January 2007)

IFRS 7 introduces new disclosures to improve the information about the financial instruments. It requires the disclosure of qualitative and quantitative information about exposure to risks arising from financial instruments, including specified minimum disclosures about credit risk, liquidity risk and market risk, including a sensitivity analysis to market risk. It replaces IAS 30, Disclosures in the Financial Statements of Banks and Similar Financial Institutions, and the disclosure requirements in IAS 32, Financial Instruments: Disclosure and Presentation. It is applicable to all entities that report under IFRS. The amendment to IAS 1 introduces disclosures about the level of an entity's capital and how it manages capital. The Group applies IFRS 7 since 1 January 2007 but as it relates to risk disclosure requirements it influences mainly the annual financial statements. The risk management disclosures (quantitative/qualitative) as such which for 2007 should be based on management reporting, will not significantly change. However, because of the change in the business structure of the Group this will affect risk management reporting.

Amendment to IAS 23, Borrowing Costs (effective from 1 January 2009)

This amendment removes the option of immediately recognizing as an expense borrowing costs that relate to assets that take a substantial period of time to get ready for use or sale. The revised standard requires that an entity capitalise such borrowing costs as part of the cost of that asset. This was a permitted alternative treatment under IAS 23. This treatment was not previously relevant for the Group and it will be applied for heavily occurring events.

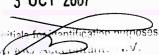

2007 to approve the acquisition of 100% stake in Nomos Bank by Russia Finance Corporation B.V., which is controlled by PPF Group.

Both PPF Group and shareholders of Nomos Bank expect the whole transaction to be completed during the fourth quarter of 2007, with the aim of creating a strategic partnership between both companies. The transaction is subject to the approval of the Central Bank of Russia. Both parties will continue working together in order to create a major universal private banking group in Russia.
