## <u>ORDER</u>

No.13180-HIII(5)/2020/7695 Dated 31/07/2020

WHEREAS an order No.40-3/2020-DM-I(A), dated 30/05/2020 was issued for containment of COVID-19 in the country, for a period upto 30/06/2020;

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers under Section 6(2)(i) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) has directed the Chairman, National Executive Committee (NEC) to issue an order to re-open more activities in a calibrated manner, in areas outside the Containment Zones and to extend the lockdown in Containment Zones upto 31/07/2020;

WHEREAS, the Chairman, NEC, in exercise of the powers, conferred under Section 10(2)(1) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, vide order dated 29/07/2020 directed that guidelines on Unlock 3, as annexed, will be in force upto 31/08/2020.

Now, therefore, the undersigned in my capacity as Chairperson, State Executive Committee of State Disaster Management Authority, UT, Chandigarh hereby directs that the orders/guidelines, as annexed herewith will remain in force upto 31/08/2020 in the entire Union Territory of Chandigarh.

Further, the following specific directions are issued for containing spread of covid infection in the city:-

- (a) Sukhna Lake will remain closed on weekends. Entry of all visitors will remain banned on Saturdays & Sundays.
- (b) Odd-even system in certain specified congested markets will be re-introduced from time to time, as per the recommendations of the Committee, headed by Finance Secretary, UT.

- (c) All markets will close by 08:00 PM, except for the eating establishments, which can remain open till 09:00 PM. However, the exemption to essential shops; such as medicines shops etc. will continue.
- (d) The curfew period from 10:00 PM to 05:00 AM 211 /on1 nul

These orders will come into force with immediate effect.

Any violation will be punishable under provisions of Section 51 to 60 of Disaster Management Act, 2005, apart from action under Section 188 of IPC and other legal provisions, as applicable.
