Whereas, the COVID-19 has been declared as pandemic by the World Health Organization and National Disaster Management Authority, being satisfied that the district is threatened with COVID-19 pandemic.

Whereas,in compliance of Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India order no 40-3/2020-DM-1 (A) dated 30.05.2020 and Government of Haryana State Disaster Management Authority order no. DMC-SPO-2020/6123 dated 30.05.2020 and in exercise of the powers under sections 30 and 34 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005. I, Amit Khatri, IAS, Deputy Commissioner-cum-Chairperson, District Disaster Management Authority, Gurugram do hereby extend the lockdown in Containment Zones upto 30.06.2020. The undersigned hereby directs that guidelines, as Annexed, will remain in force upto 30.06.2020.

The following activities will continue to remain prohibited until further decision is taken on their phase-wise opening:

(i) Metro Rail Services.

All schools, colleges, educational /training/coaching institution etc will remain closed. Online / Distance learning shall continue to be permitted and shall be encouraged.

Hotels and other hospitality services, except those meant for housing health/Police/Government officials/healthcare workers/stranded persons including tourists and those used for quarantine/isolation facilities; and running of canteens at bus depots, railway stations and airports

All Cinema halls, shopping malls, gymnasiums, swimming pools, entertainment parks, theatres, bars and auditoriums, assembly halls and similar places.

- (v) All Social/political/sports/entertainment/academic/cultural/religious functions/ other gatherings and large congregations.
- (vi) All religious places/places of worship shall be closed for public. Religious congregations are strictly prohibited.
- (vii) Spas.

- 2. The following activities are permitted with restrictions as specified. No permission is required from any authority for undertaking the following permitted activities:
 - Restaurants shall be permitted to operate kitchens for home delivery and Takeaway of food items.
 - (ii) All Private Offices as well as Government Offices shall be permitted to function in full strength. However, for private offices, as far as possible the practice of work from home should be followed.

3. Commerce, Industry & Services

- (a) All permitted shops, other than essential goods, can open from 09:00 AM to 07:00 PM to ensure the compliance of night curfew regarding movement of individuals between 09:00 PM to 05:00 AM as per SOP issued by Urban Local Bodies Department in this regard..
- (b) Social distancing (2 Gaz ki doori) will be maintained in all cases. If social distancing is not maintained by any shop, then the said shop shall be liable to be closed in view of public health hazard involved in containing the spread of COVID-19 pandemic and the shopkeeper shall also be liable for prosecution under the relevant laws.
- (c) Industrial establishments shall be permitted to operate as per SOP issued by Industries Department in this regard.
- (d) Construction activities shall be permitted wherever the workers are available on site or could be transported to the site from within the district.
- (e) RWAs shall not prevent any person from performing their services and duties which have been permitted under these guidelines or for general movement into/within the Society.

4. National Directives for COVID-19 Management

National Directives for COVID-19 Management, as specified in Annexure I, shall continue to be followed throughout the district.

Lockdown limited to Containment Zones.

- Lockdown shall continue to remain in force in the Containment Zones till 30 June, 2020.
- In the Containment Zones, Only essential activities shall be allowed. There
 shall be no movement of people in or out of these zones, except for medical
 emergencies and for maintaining supply of essential goods and services.



Measures for well-being and safety of persons:

 The movement of individuals shall remain strictly prohibited between 09.00 PM to 05.00 AM, except for essential activities as per this office order dated 31.05.2020.

8. Unrestricted Movement of persons and goods.

- There shall be no restriction on intra State movement of persons and goods No separate permission/approval/e-permit will be required for such movements.
- Inter-state movement shall continue to be regulated by previous orders and mechanism in this regard.
- iii. Movement by passenger trains and Shramik special trains; domestic passenger air travel; movement of Indian Nationals stranded outside the country and of specified persons to travel abroad; will continue to be regulated as per SOPs issued.

Protection of vulnerable persons.

Persons above 65 years of age, persons with co-morbidities, pregnant women, and children below the age of 10 years are advised to stay at home.

10. Use of Aarogya Setu/IVRS

Use of Aarogya Setu app shall be made mandatory on all compatible mobiles phones of all employees, both private and public. It shall be the responsibility of the Heads of the respective Organizations to ensure 100% coverage of this app among the employees.

II. For persons who do not own smart phones, the option "Aarogya IVRS 1921 service" launched by the GOI for feature phones and landlines may be utilised for sharing information about the employee's health status.

All the Departments/concerned shall ensure strict compliance of this order as well as MHA order dated 30.05.2020. Government of Haryana State Disaster Management Authority order no. DMC-SPO-2020/6123 dated 30.05.2020, Urban Local Bodies Haryana SOP dated 31.05.2020, Transport Department, Haryana SOP dated 01.06.2020 and Department of Sports and Youth Affairs SOP dated 31.05.2020 along with annexed guidelines and SOPs and Annexures 1 & 11. Any violation of these instructions/orders is liable to criminal prosecution under section 51 to 60 of Disaster Management Act, 2005.
