ORDERUNDER SECTION 144 Cr. P.C)

This Order is in continuation to Office Order No. SLN/Reader/DM/1-14/89-IV-7493 dated 1st July, 2020 issued by the undersigned, vide which operation of provisions of Section 144 of the Cr. P.C. (CURFEW) has been ordered to remain continued in the entire territorial jurisdiction of District Solan till further orders.

WHEREAS, the Union Home Secretary and Chairman, National Executive Committee (NEC) has issued Order No. 40-3/2020-DM-1(A) dated 29th June, 2020 vide which certain more activities have been permitted to re-open in areas outside the Containment Zones and Lockdown in Containment Zones has been extended upto 31.07.2020,

AND WHEREAS, the Chief Secretary to the Government of Himachal Pradesh-cum-Chairperson State Executive Committee (SEC), vide Order No. Rev. (DNC) (C) 20-2/2020-COVID-19 dated 2nd July, 2020 has issued guidelines with respect to opening of more activities outside the Containment Zones in the State of Himachal Pradesh and has directed all District Magistrates to ensure strict compliance of its directions.

THEREFORE, keeping in view the above mentioned Order issued by the Chief Secretary to the Government of Himachal Pradesh-cum-Chairperson (SEC), I, K.C. Chaman, (IAS) District Magistrate, Solan do hereby order to re-open more activities in District Solan, with certain restrictions as indicated below;-

 Religious places/places of worship shall be opened only as per the SOPs to be issued by the Department of Language Art and Culture, HP after ensuring full readiness to comply with the SOPs.

 Tourism units shall operate as per the SOPs issued by the Department of Tourism Department as well as undersigned vide this Office Order No. SLN/Reader/DM/1-14/89-IV-6449 dated 11th June, 2020.

 The Government Offices will function as per the SOPs issued by the Department of Personnel vide Order No. Per. (AP-B) B(15)-19/2020 dated 31st May, 2020.

District Magistrate Restaurant/Dhabas can serve food by operating at 60% of their seating capacity and in Solan District Soid Corplance with SOPs issued by the Department of Tourism Department as well as undersigned vide Office Order No. SLN/Reader/DM/1-14/89-IV-6449 dated 11th June, 2020.

The Medical Colleges are allowed to open in District Solan for final year students to strengthen the Health System in coming days along with the health training institutions from 15th July 2020 subject to the SOPs issued by Department of Health and Family Welfare.

A. SOPS ON MOVEMENT OF PERSONS:

(iii)

- Movement of individuals shall remain strictly prohibited between 9.00 PM to 5.00 1. AM throughout the District, except for essential activities, including operation of industrial units in multiple shifts, movement of persons and goods on National and State Highways, loading and unloading of cargo and travel of persons to their destination after disembarking from buses, trains and airplanes.
- The SOPs for movement of travellers through domestic flights and trains will be as 2. issued by the Government of India from time to time.
- Inter-State movement of Industrial Workers, Industrialists, Traders, Raw material Suppliers, Service Providers, Inspecting Authorities and artihyas shall remain regulated 3. as per the SOPs issued by the undersigned vide order No. SLN/Reader/DM/1-14/89-IV-5701 dated 24th May, 2020, No. 7153 & 7155 dated 25th June, 2020.

However, these SOPs will stand modified to the extent indicated in this various clauses of this Order with respect to movement timings, requirements of entry to the State and applicability of quarantine requirements.

B. MONITORING THE SPREAD OF COVID-19 AND CONTACT TRACING:

In order to contain spread of COVID19 and ensure proper contact tracing in case of detection of COVID19 positive cases, the following measures will be taken:-

All inter-State movement to the District will be monitored through registration in COVID e-Pass Software (http://coxid19epass.hp.gov.in to monitor compliance (i) with quarantine requirements and facilitate contact tracing of persons in the event of detection of COVID-19 positive cases. All persons desirous of entering the Distit Schn formater State shall enter their particulars in this online software and details of their arrival will be shared with all concerned for the purpose of quarantine requirement and contact tracing.

The Orchardists/Agriculturists/Contractors/Project Proponents shall ensure registration of all labourer brought to the District Solan from other States in COVID e-(ii) Pass Software (http://covid19epass.hp.gov.in).

The persons travelling to the District Solan or entering the District through rail and air route may do so on the basis of ticket/boarding pass. However, they

Solan District Solan H. Rhould also register in COVID e-Pass Software (http://covid19epass.hp.gov.in). Daily/weekend commuters such as industrialists, traders, suppliers, factory (iv)

- workers, project proponents etc. may enter and exit the State as per SOPs. Those who have already obtained permission in this regard need not to register again.
- (v) The Members of Armed Forces and Central Paramilitary Forces coming to the State or crossing through the District to join back their duty can enter/pass through the District on the strength of their official identity card without the requirement of registration in COVID e-Pass Software.
- (vi) The people coming to this District from other States shall strictly adhere to the prevailing Guidelines/SOPs issued by Department of Health and Family Welfare and Revenue Department (Disaster Management) of the State.

C. PUBLIC TRANSPORT AND MOVEMENT OF VEHICLES:

- Inter-State movement of public transport buses will remain prohibited. Taxis however can ply with permission of the undersigned.
- Pass free inter-district movement of public transport buses, private vehicles, taxis and autos is allowed.
- Stage Carrier Public transport (HRTC and Private Buses) are allowed to operate with adequate measures for containment of COVID-19.
- (iv) The public transport taxis and private vehicles may ply on roads during the permitted hours.

D. QUARANTINE REQUIREMENTS:

- (i) The quarantine period for returnee(s) to this District from other States will be as per the guidelines issued by the Department of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of HP from time to time.
- (ii) All persons coming from high load COVID-19 infected cities, as notified by the Health and Family Welfare Department of Himachal Pradesh from time to time will be institutionally quarantined. Only for exceptional and compelling reasons such as cases of human distress, pregnancy, death in family, serious illness and parent(s) accompanied by Children below 10 years, Old age persons above the age of 65 years accompanied by the attendants as assessed by the receiving district and found justified, home quarantine may be permitted for 14 days. All such person exempted from Institutional Quarantine shall make themselves available for COVID-19 testing and shall immediately contact concerned BMO/Health Authorities after their arrival. If the person is carrying a personal COVID test report issued by a arrival. If the person is carrying a personal COVID test report issued by a lab authorized by ICMR, which is negative and has been issued within the last 3 days prior to the date of journey, then Institutional Quarantine need not be insisted & he/she can straightway go for home quarantine.

- (iii) All asymptomatic persons coming all other States/Cities will be home quarantined as per the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India, guidelines issued from time to time. The persons who will be Home Quarantined will report to concerned BMO/Health Authorities and local police (SHO/Chowki Incharge) within 24 hours of arrival, otherwise action will be taken as per rules/guidelines.
- (iv) All persons coming from abroad will be quarantined as per the guidelines of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India, guidelines issued from time to time.
- (v) All symptomatic and persons with ILI symptoms may be kept in institutional quarantine facilities.
- (vi) All persons who jump home quarantine will be immediately shifted to institutional quarantine facilities.
- (vii) There shall be no requirement of quarantine for the students and their accompanying parents who need to move in and out of the District to other State(s) due to competitive examinations, provided they exit or re-enter this District within a period of 48 hours.
- (viii) Those asking for better facilities other than identified by the District Administration may be quarantined in paid facilities pre-identified and notified by the District administration.

- The Orchardists/Agriculturist/Contractors/Project Proponents shall arrange for quarantine facility of all labour brought to this District from other States. The migrant labourer coming in the State can be sent directly to the work site of the Orchardist/ Agriculturists/ Contractor/ Project Proponents arranging separate transport. The labour can start working at these sites immediately subject to observing all the due precautions including social distancing, not mixing up with local population and the constant monitoring for symptoms as is being done for quarantined persons. The period of active surveillance shall however continue to be the same as per the period prescribed by the guidelines issued by the Department of Health & family Welfare.
- (x) Industrial workers, industrialists, traders, raw material suppliers, service providers, inspecting authorities will be exempted from purview of Home Quarantine.
- (xi) The persons visiting this District from other States for bonafide purpose of trade, business, job, project, service purpose, marriage ceremonies, commission agents, with supporting documents and not coming from high load cities and other containment zones from rest of the country, will be exempted from the purview of quarantine.
- (xii) Daily /weekend commuters entering this District through Interstate barriers shall be

exempted from any quarantine requirement. However, it will be the individual's personal responsibility to report at health facility in case of the flu/ ILI symptoms.

- The residents of this District exiting the District to visit other States for short (xiii) duration for medical, business or office purpose and coming back to the District within 48 hours, shall be exempted from any requirement of quarantine, provided they are asymptomatic.
- The tourists with valid booking, preferably for duration not less than 5 days and (xiv) having been tested negative for COVID-19 by an ICMR accredited laboratory not earlier than 72 hours at the time of entry are exempted from the requirement of quarantine.

E. USE OF AAROGYA SETU APP:

- Use of Aarogya Setu app shall be mandatory for all persons entering this District. (i)
- With a view to ensuring safety in offices and workplaces, employers on best effort (ii) basis should ensure that Aarogya Setu is installed by all employees having compatible mobile phones.
- The individuals are advised to install the Aarogya Setu application on compatible mobile (iii) phones and regularly update their health status on the app. This will facilitate timely provision of medical attention to those individuals who are at risk.

F. NATIONAL DIRECTIVES FOR COVID-19 MANAGEMENT:

National Directives for COVID-19 Management, as specified in Annexure-I of the NEC guidelines, shall be strictly followed.

This Order and all previous Orders/SOPs issued by the undersigned from time to time with respect to regulation of COVID-19 shall remain in force throughout the territorial jurisdiction of this District till further Orders.

ANNEXURE-I

National Directives for COVID-19 Management

- Face coverings: Wearing of face cover is compulsory in public place; in workplaces; and during transport.
- Social distancing: Individuals must maintain a minimum distance of 6 feet (2gaz ki doori) in public places.
- Gatherings: Large public gatherings/congregations continue to remain prohibited.
 Marriage related gatherings: Number of guests not exceeds 50.
 Funeral/last rites related gatherings: Number of persons not to exceed 20.
- Spitting in public places: will be punishable with fine, as may be prescribed by the State local authority in accordance with its laws, rules of regulations.
- Consumption of liquor, paan, gutka, tobacco etc. in public place is prohibited.

Additional directives for work places.

- Work from home (WfH): As far as possible the practice of WfH should be followed.
- Staggering of work/business hours: will be followed in offices, work places, shops, markets and industrial & commercial establishments.
- Screening & hygiene: provision for thermal scanning, hand wash and sanitizer will be made at all entry and exit points and common areas.
- Frequent sanitization: of entire workplace, common facilities and all points which
 come into human contact e.g. door handles etc. will be ensured, including between
 chifts
- 10. Social distancing: All persons in charge of work places will ensure adequate distance between workers, adequate gaps between shifts, staggering the lunch breaks of staff etc.
