NOTIFICATION

Dispur, the 22nd August, 2022

GLR(RC)40/2022/36: The Governor of Assam is pleased to enhance the minimum wages of the tea plantation workers in the State of Assam by an interim wage of Rs.27/-per day w.e.f. 1st August, 2022 as was agreed by the stakeholders. Accordingly, the tea plantation workers in Brahmaputra Valley shall get an interim minimum wage of Rs.232/- per day from existing Rs.205/- per day and the tea plantation workers in Barak Valley shall get Rs.210/- per day from the existing Rs.183/- per day till further orders.

The interim minimum wages for small tea garden workers will also be pegged at Rs 232/- per day in Brahmaputra Valley and Rs 210/- per day in Barak Valley in Assam w.e.f. 1st August, 2022 till further orders.
