No. FW/Election, 2022/ 3648 -Whereas the General Election of Panchayati Raj Institutions for which poll shall be held on the 13.12.2022(Tuesday) as per letter of the State Election Commissioner, Haryana issued vide No. SEC/4E-II/2022/8708-8709 dated 06.12.2022.

And whereas, it has been considered necessary to provide opportunity to the public to exercise their franchise.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 65 of the Factories Act, 1948 (Central Act 63 of 1948) and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Haryana is pleased to exempt all the adult workers working in the factories situated in the State of Haryana who are the voters in aforesaid General Elections for Panch Ward No. 5, Gram Panchayat Rukhi Khas, Block Gohana, Distt. Sonipat is to be held on 13.12.2022 from the operations of provisions of sub-section (1) of section 52 of the said Act, for the week commencing from 11.12.2022 and ending 17.12.2022, subject to the condition that no adult worker who is enrolled as voter in aforesaid General Election for Panch Ward No. 5, Gram Panchayat Rukhi Khas, Block Gohana, Distt. Sonipat shall be required or allowed to work on 13.12.2022 (Tuesday) in the factories of the state of Haryana.
