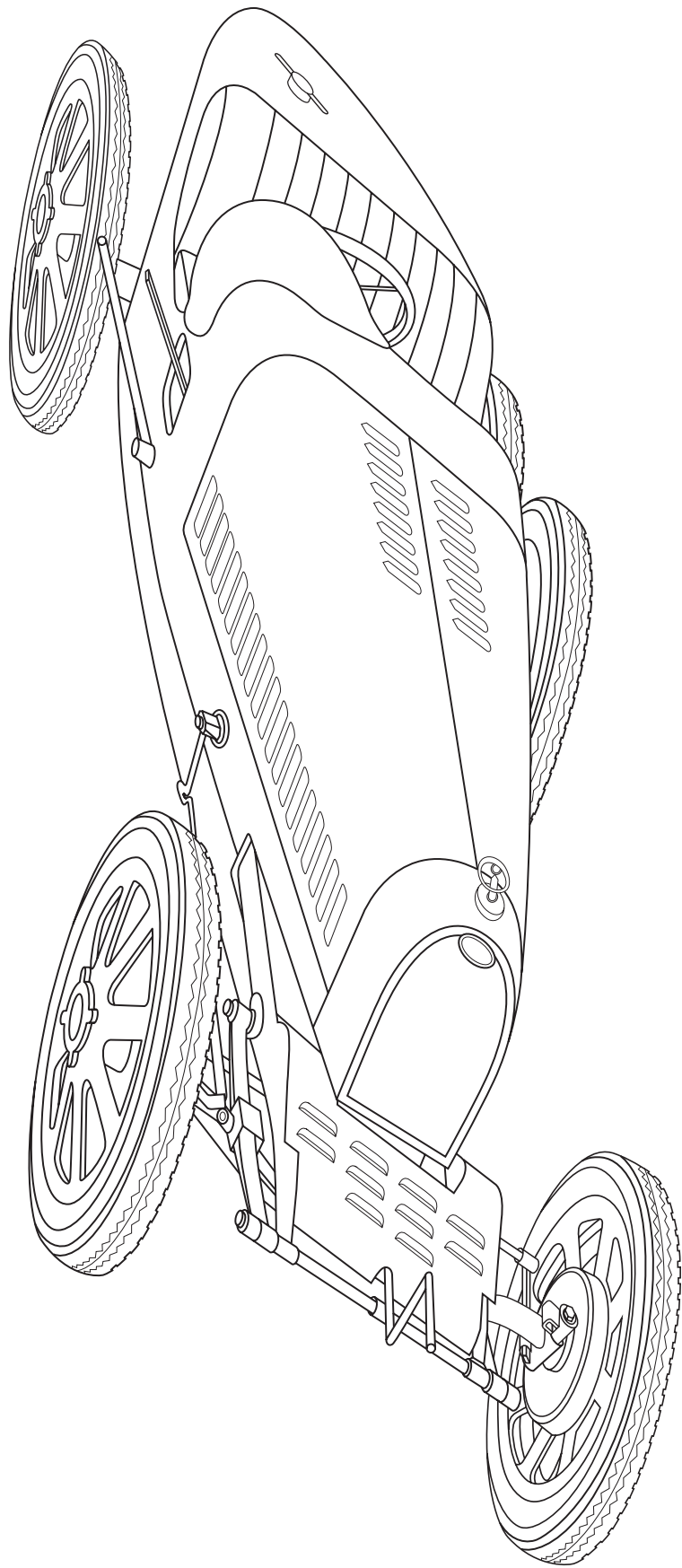

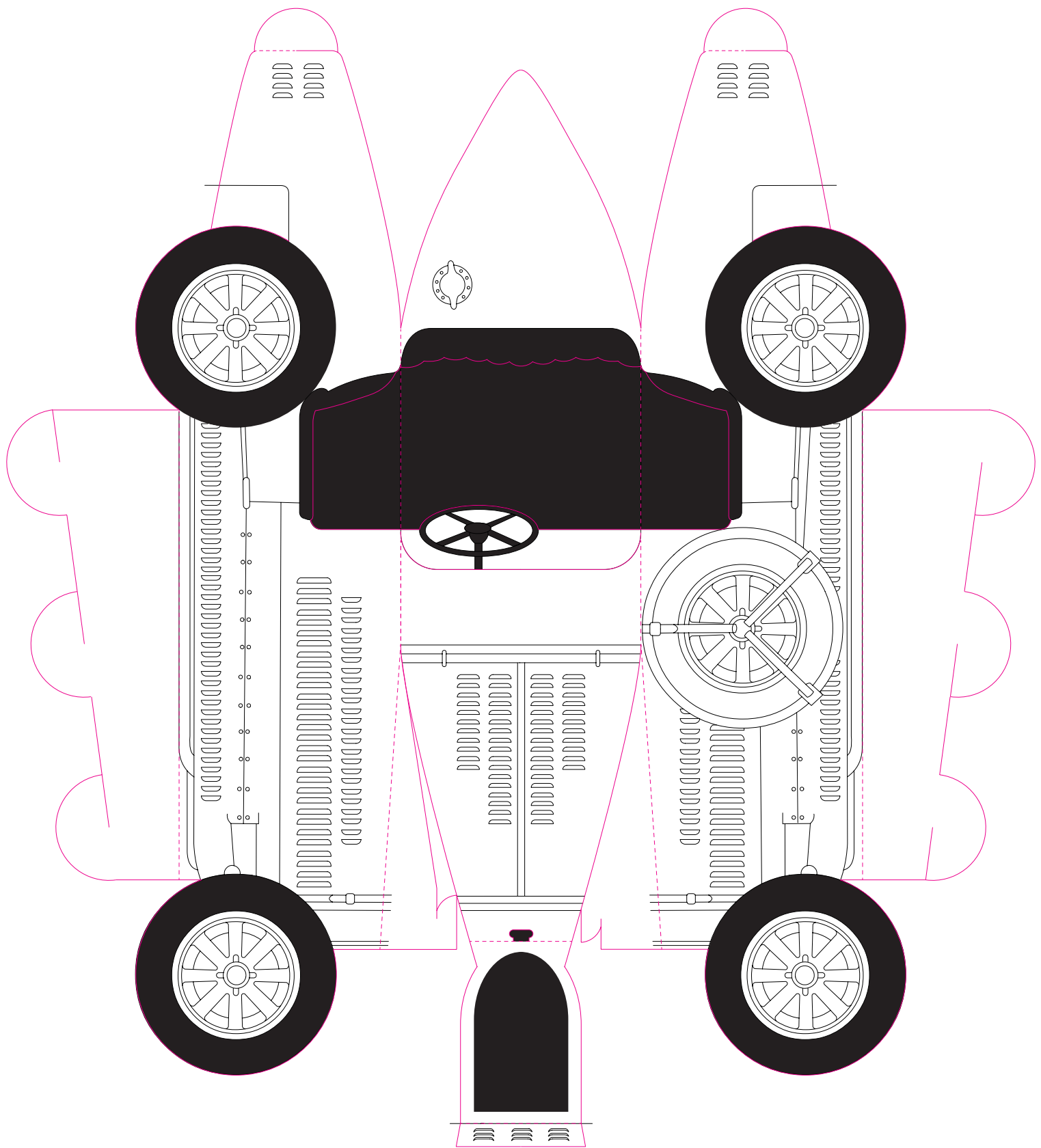
On the next page
