Into the Blue

The artworks on display here were created in the decades after 1940 by Australian women who ventured overseas to study, paint and live. This selection from the Art Gallery's collection imagines the next chapter of our major exhibition *Dangerously Modern: Australian Women Artists in Europe 1890–1940*.

For some artists, Europe held allure – Elisabeth Cummings painted her intimate interior *Afternoon with gin fizz* 1961 in Florence, Italy, after winning the NSW Travelling Art Scholarship. Others headed for the new art capital of New York, including Nancy Borlase, Virginia Cuppaidge and Denise Green. Cuppaidge's large-scale, geometric painting *Blue talor* 1975 is an exemplar of colour-field abstraction, a style that originated in New York in the 1950s. From Janet Alderson's bullfighting-inspired abstraction *Manolete* 1966 to the urban architecture of Green's *Laight Street, view no 1* 1974, these paintings reveal the invigorating effects of time spent in new places.

Dangerously Modern: Australian Women Artists in Europe 1890–1940 is on display until 15 February 2026 in the Naala Nura building.
