

 $\rightarrow$  l View from street, glass and aluminum façade


## La Serenissima Office Building

## Milan

This building, previously known as Palazzo Campari, is located in Milan and was designed in the 1960s by Ermenegildo and Eugenio Soncini. Boxes clad in perforated and pressformed aluminum are used in a rhythm that enables the elevation to be reworked and which also ensures maximum flexibility in terms of internal spatial organization. In the courtyard, a close relationship has been developed between the interior and exterior. On Via Cavalieri the original lower elevation appears sleek and flat. The predominant use of gray for the glazed surfaces, gives the building its smooth appearance and reflects the historic surroundings.
