A new genus and species of callipodidan milliped from Vietnam (Callipodida, Schizopetalidae)

ABSTRACT

Scotopetalum warreni, n. gen., n. sp., is described from a cave near Hanoi, Viertnam. The new species shows troglobitic adaptations, and is most similar in gonopod structure to members of the North American genus Colactis. This is the first record of a schizopetalid from southeast Asia. Two newly proposed families of callipodidans from that region, Paracortinidae Wang & Zhang, and Sinocallipodidae Zhang, are briefly discussed. Paracortinidae is probably synonymous with Schizopetalidae. A new suborder, Sinocallipodidea, is proposed for the latter family.
