The milliped genus *Diplomaragna* confirmed for Taiwan,
with the description of a new species (Diplopoda,
Chordeumatida, Diplomaragnidae)

ABSTRACT

Syntelopodeuma formosanum was described by Verhoeff from the island of Tawiwan (Formosa) in 1936. Recent inspection of the type confirmed that this species is a member of the genus *Diplomaragna*. In addition, a second Tawiwaneese species, *Diplomaragna australis*, is described as new, strong evidence that the genus is native to Taiwan, some 1200 miles south of its nearest record in Shikoku, Japan.
