



While on Field Museum premises, no Member or Visitor shall:

Carry firearms, other dangerous or deadly weapons, explosives, or other hazardous materials either openly or concealed while on the premises.

Destroy, damage, or remove property of the Museum or of other guests.

Climb upon any part of the building, exterior or interior, or exhibitions.

Use vulgar, obscene, threatening, harassing, discriminatory, disrespectful, or otherwise inappropriate language or exhibit other such behavior toward other guests or Museum staff, including wearing clothing with vulgar, obscene, or disrespectful images or messages.

Engage in rowdy or disruptive behavior, such as fighting, running, shouting, or pushing.

Perform obscene or indecent acts.

Loiter, sleep, or participate in unwarranted assemblies.

Create any hazard to persons or things.

Use, possess, distribute, or sell illegal drugs.

Solicit for commercial, charitable, or political purposes or distribute or post advertisements, pamphlets, handbills, and flyers.

Display, carry, or post placards, signs, or banners.

Smoke, this includes e-cigarette devices.

Bring dogs or other animals other than service animals.

Use bicycles, scooters, skateboards, roller skates, wheeled shoes, Segways, hoverboards, or similar devices (except those used as an assistive device by a person with a disability).

Attempt to access areas of the Museum that are not open to the public, including any exhibition areas that have been closed.

Eat or drink outside of designated areas.

Make photographs, audio/visual recordings, or scans for any purpose except for personal, non-commercial use; disobey posted no photography signs; or bring tripods, or other professional photography equipment without authorization.

Disrupt the Museum's ability to carry on its normal operations.

Refuse to follow the Museum's visitor policies or the directions of Museum staff.
