Exhibition Overview

Discover a unique paleontological learning experience with Pokémon—connect the iconic entertainment franchise with prehistoric fossils.

Featuring side-by-side displays of vibrant Pokémon and extinct life forms from the Field Museum's collection, the exhibition encourages visitors to use their powers of observation to make connections and to see differences between the specimens and fossil Pokémon.



Pokémon 101

From Japan, Pokémon translates to “pocket monsters.” In the wildly popular video game series, some Pokémon can be restored from fossils into living creatures using a Restoration machine. Pokémon are mysterious creatures living in various environments, but there is still much unknown about their ecology.

Examine and Compare

Similarities can be found between fossil Pokémon and prehistoric life forms. Visitors compare real fossils and specimen casts from Field Museum superstars like SUE the *T. rex* and the Chicago *Archaeopteryx* with similar Pokémon like Tyranntrum and Archeops.

Pathways to Science

Follow the Pokémon Professors to uncover the science behind Pokémon behavior and ecology. Both fun and educational, the exhibition encourages visitors of all ages to be curious about the natural world. Explore fossil hunting, excavation, cleaning, and identification; study fossil clues and speculate about ecosystems and geological periods; compare competition in both the real world and Pokémon world; and learn why natural history museums collect.
