


There's still much to accomplish, and I am eagerly looking forward to continuing this journey of transforming education and empowering individuals.

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
2. CODAM STUDENTS

In 2024, the Codam community composition looks like this:




Prior education

Embracing diversity and inclusion means that we actively build and facilitate an inclusive learning environment for everyone from all walks of life.


Female representation


Neurodiversity

Since 2018, Codam has provided financial support to **621 Selection Piscine** participants and students, amounting to a total of \le 370,000.


2.3 Student clubs

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3. PRACTICE-BASED EDUCATION

In 2 years, our students will become solutions-driven, resilient, creative, and confident team players with excellent programming skills. They are industry ready.

To get there, they have to finish at least 16 programming projects from the curriculum. This ensures that Codam students have spent **more than 4x time on programming** compared to traditional university bachelor courses.

Besides coding, our students are experienced in giving and receiving code reviews. A student engages in at least 100 code reviews during their studies. This gives them an edge.

3.1 Industry-ready

From day one, our education emphasises adaptability to new challenges and technologies.

With a strong focus on group work, knowledge sharing, and mutual support, we cultivate a collaborative environment.

Instead of simply learning to program, we encourage students to identify what they need to learn to solve problems, embodying our 'Learning to Learn' philosophy.

This approach empowers students to be confident and ready for any challenge that comes their way.

3.2 Transformative education

Codam's educational approach inspires a transformative experience. Our education goes beyond just gaining technical skills. As students journey through our curriculum, they not only master technology but also experience a remarkable growth in confidence and a bright outlook on their future.



4.2 High employment satisfaction

It is rewarding to see how well the technical abilities and interpersonal skills mastered by our students align with the needs of the companies. This is evident as companies who hire our students consistently reaffirm their satisfaction, with a steady average **evaluation score of 4.6** out of 5.

5. SCALING IMPACT

Our educational model is scalable largely because our peer learning approach does not depend on teachers. We don't need to engage in the time-consuming and costly processes of training or hiring additional teaching staff to accommodate more students. For many universities, the shortage of teaching staff can be so problematic that only a fixed quota of students can be accepted (numerus fixus).

Cost-effective

Codam doesn't impose tuition fees on our students, the foundation covers the necessary costs for their education. Our different approach allows us to be scalable and cost-effective. With an **annual investment of € 5,957 per student**, Codam significantly undercut traditional university costs, demonstrating a different use of resources that supports scalability.
