Ronan Kerloc'h appointed Managing Director at Keolis Rennes

- Ronan Kerloc'h has been appointed to the position of Managing Director of Keolis Rennes, operator of the [STAR](#) public transport network on behalf of Rennes Métropole, as of 1st April 2022. He succeeds Laurent Senigout.
- Ronan will oversee the launch and progressive development of the network's second automatic metro line, due to open at the end of May 2022, and the reorganization of the new bus network.

Ronan Kerloc'h's career

Ronan Kerloc'h, 56, is a graduate of IDRAC business school in Paris and of HEC (2004).

In 2015, he joined **Keolis Group** as *Regional Director* in charge of five subsidiaries in the Eure-et-Loir, Loir-et-Cher and Loiret departments, overseeing public transport network operations in the towns of [Dreux](#), [Montargis](#) and [Blois](#).

In 2018, he joined the île-de-France branch of Keolis as *Regional Director* for the Seine-et-Marne, Seine-Saint-Denis and Val-d'Oise departments where he managed five business units including [Les Courriers d'île de France](#) (950 employees and 110 lines) and Filéo, one of Europe's largest on-demand transport services linking the airport sector of Roissy-Charles de Gaulle with Seine-Saint-Denis, Val-d'Oise and northwest Seine-et-Marne.

He began his career in 1989 in mass catering. He held several positions including Deputy Managing Director France for the **Compass Group**, in charge of regional business for several Compass Group business units (**Eurest**, **Medirest** and **Scolarest**).
