## Network connect/disconnect instructions

## Initial Network Setup for the Yoto player

To set up your Yoto player, you'll need the Yoto App installed on your mobile phone.

### Step-by-Step Setup:

- 1. Open the Yoto App and select "Join a family account."
- 2. Power on the Yoto player.
- Connect it to the charger.
- Ensure no NFC card is inserted.
- Press and hold both orange buttons for 5 seconds until the screen shows six letters and you hear the voice prompt: "Enter this code into the app to continue."
- 3. In the app, select your Yoto unit type and enter the six-letter code shown on the screen.
- 4.Once the unit is successfully paired, a tick mark (√) will appear on the screen.
- 5. Follow the in-app instructions to connect the unit to WiFi.
- The unit will now automatically reconnect to this WiFi whenever powered on.

## **Managing WiFi Connections**

#### To disconnect or remove a WiFi network:

- 1. Ensure the Mini Player is powered on and connected to WiFi.
- 2. Open the Yoto App and go to the Settings page.
- 3. Tap the name of your Player to access its settings.
- 4. Select "Manage" > "Manage Wi-Fi".
- 5. Tap "Disconnect" to temporarily disconnect (it will reconnect after restart).
- 6. Tap "Forget ALL" to delete all stored WiFi networks from the Player.

#### Bluetooth Mode

Turn Bluetooth ON:

- While the Player is on and idle, press and hold the left button for 3 seconds to enter Bluetooth mode.
- Then, briefly press and hold the right button to enable Bluetooth.
- The device is now discoverable and ready to pair. Turn Bluetooth OFF:
- Press and hold the left button for 3 seconds again while in Bluetooth mode.
