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§ 1. Application of the Tariff.

- The Tariff defining fees for services is adopted by the Szczecin and Świnoujście Seaports Authority, hereinafter referred to as the Ports Authority, based on the Resolution of the Board of the Ports Authority No 1 of 6th January 2006 as amended.
- 2. The Tariff is effective as of 01.03.2006.
- 3. The Tariff is applicable in Szczecin and Świnoujście seaports.
- 4. Fees included in the Tariff are binding provided contracting Parties have agreed otherwise.
- 5. The terms of services not listed in the Tariff shall be determined by a separate agreement between the parties.
- 6. The Tariff set by the Ports Authority covers the following services:
 - collection of waste from ships,
 - services provided by the Port Fire Service, and
 - water supply.
- 7. The obligation to pay fees arises when the service is performed by the Ports Authority.
- 8. Rates specified in the Tariff are subject to indexation after the end of each calendar year against the average annual increase in the consumer price index published by the President of the Central Statistical Office (CSO) for the previous year, provided the index exceeds 100. The amendment of the rates due to indexation does not constitute a change of the tariff terms and conditions. The rates indexed in the above-mentioned manner are effective from 1st April of each calendar year and shall be included in the Tariff immediately after the publication by the CSO.

§ 2. Collection

- 1. Rates for services provided are expressed in PLN exclusive of VAT.
- 2. The minimum fee is PLN 50.00.
- 3. Fee referred to in point 2 does not apply to ship waste collection.
- 4. Rates do not include VAT VAT at the level valid on the date of the service is added to the rates.

§ 3. Collection of waste from ships

The Tariff is valid together with the 'Information on the procedure and method of collecting waste from ships at quays located within the seaport of Szczecin and Świnoujście'.

- The master/agent of a ship calling at the ports of Szczecin or Świnoujście shall provide 'Information about disposable waste on board before the ship enters the port' through the Polish Harbour Information and Control System (PHICS). The information form shall be completed in detail in due time required by the law (Regulation of Minister of Transport, Construction, and Maritime Affairs of 11th January 2013 on the provision of information on waste on board, OJ item 77 of 17.01.2013.
- 2. As part of the tonnage fee charged by the Ports Authority and defined in the Tariff, ships calling at ports of Szczecin and Świnoujście shall be entitled to deliver waste types and quantities listed in Table 1 'Type and quantity of ship waste covered by the tonnage fee'. An additional fee is collected for excess waste as specified in Table 1; the Ports Authority charges an additional fee according to Table 2 'Additional fees'.
- 3. A limit on the quantity and types of waste is granted only once at the ship's entry to the port based on the 'Information about waste on board to be delivered in the port of Szczecin/Świnoujście' and the tonnage fee. The limit authorises the ship to a single delivery of waste generated during the ship's journey from the last port of call to the port of Szczecin/Świnoujście; any subsequent notification of the need to deliver waste, the master/agent of the ship shall file with the port authority using the 'Declaration of waste to be delivered at the seaport...' and shall be subject to a special fee depending on the unused limit.
- 4. Ships exempt from port charges and special vessels whose tonnage fee is PLN 0.00 do not have a limit on the quantity and types of waste granted and pay the collection fee for ship waste at rates listed in Table 2 'Additional fees'.
- 5. Vessels referred to in Article 3. 8 of the Tariff, which pay 50% in their tonnage fee, have a 50% limit on the quantity and types of waste to be delivered.
- 6. Ships Strażak-24 and Strażak-26 are exempt from the fees for the collection of waste.
- 7. Waste is collected from ships having the exemption of the Director of the Maritime Office in Szczecin from the obligation to deliver waste before leaving the port and from short sea passenger ships engaged in liner shipping (Regulation of the Minister of Infrastructure of 12 May 2003 on exemptions to ships from the obligation to deliver waste before leaving the port, OJ No 101, Item 937, as amended), following rules set out in Table 1 'Types and quantities of ship waste covered by the tonnage fee', provided that the transfer of liquid oily waste takes place once every two weeks. If liquid oily waste is delivered more often, the limit is reduced by 50%.
- 8. The collection of waste from ships at different times and conditions than those established by the Seaports Authority shall be subject to a special fee set out in Table 3.
- 9. The Szczecin and Świnoujście Seaports Authority does not ensure the collection of cargo residues from ships. Collection fees are determined directly between the requesting company and the waste collection company.

- 10. The reception of wastewater from ferries is based on the results of physical and chemical tests performed on samples of sewage collected by the Seaports Authority. Tests shall be carried out by a laboratory of the Seaports Authority or another laboratory selected by the Seaports Authority or the Świnoujście Water Management Company (ZWiK) accredited with the Polish Accreditation Centre (PCA) or another accreditation body which is a signatory to the EA MLA/ILAC MRA.
- 11. In the case wastewater is delivered on a regular basis by ferries in the ports of Świnoujście or Szczecin, the Seaports Authority collects samples of wastewater and tests them at 1 least once a month at its own cost. The Seaports Authority or the Świnoujście Water Management Company (ZWiK) may, at its own cost, carry out more frequent sampling and testing of sewage during a given month. The result of the test is valid for determining fees for the collection of wastewater from the day of the test until the day of the next test.
- 12. The shipowner/operator shall be notified about sampling not later than 2 hours in advance to an electronic address indicated by the shipowner/operator, after prior notification by the shipowner/operator of his intention to deliver wastewater in the port. A representative of the shipowner/operator may be present during sampling.
- 13. The owner/operator of a ferry may, at his own cost, perform a wastewater test in a laboratory accredited by the PCA or another accreditation body, which is a signatory to the EA MLA/ILAC MRA, and deliver results to the Seaports Authority.
- 14. In case wastewater samples from a ferry exceed maximum limit values for pollutants as laid down by the Regulation of the Minister of Construction of 14th July 2006 on the obligation of parties delivering industrial wastewater and conditions for the discharging of wastewater to the sewage system (OJ of 2006, item 1757), the wastewater treatment plant for:
 - a. the Port of Świnoujście Water Company (ZWIK Świnoujście),
 - b. Port of Szczecin Water Company "Międzyodrze".

evaluates the possibility to receive such wastewater.

Limit values for pollutants are made available by the Seaports Authority at a written request by the shipowner/operator or the agent.

- 15. In case a wastewater treatment plant decides to receive wastewater which exceeds limit values, the shipowner/operator is charged with an additional fee depending on the type and excess contamination according to Table 3 'Special fees', point 16. The additional fee for the exceeding of limit values is calculated according to a tariff applied by the wastewater treatment plant relevant for the port concerned.
- 16. The shipowner/operator shall be immediately notified in case the wastewater treatment plant refuses to accept wastewater due to excess pollution. The Seaports Authority ensures the possibility to receive contaminated wastewater at the rate specified in Table 3 'Special fees, point 17.
