Day 1: 29 March 2024 Tokyo, Japan

Welcome to Tokyo! After clearing customs, meet your guide in the arrival hall. ^From the airport, you will first visit the outside of the Imperial Palace, located on the former site of Edo Castle, a large park area surrounded by moats and massive stone walls in the centre of Tokyo, and the residence of Japan's Imperial Family. Although the Palace is not open to the public, from Kokyo Gaien, the large plaza in front of the Imperial Palace, you can view the Nijubashi, two bridges that form an entrance to the inner palace grounds. The stone bridge in front is called Meganebashi (Eyeglass Bridge) for its looks. After the visit of Imperial grounds, hop on your private coach and transfer to Tokyo Tower. Climb the emblematic Tokyo Tower, and from the observation deck, enjoy spectacular views of the city.

Day 2: 30 March 2024 Tokyo, Japan

This morning after breakfast, join your transfer to Yokohama cruise port and embark on your 14 night cruise.

Day 3: 31 March 2024 At sea

Day 4: 01 April 2024 Osaka, Japan

Osaka is Japan's second largest metropolitan area after Tokyo. Along with plenty of shopping and modern attractions, Osaka also has a historical side, the highlight of which is Osaka Castle. The castle is a great place to discover more about Japanese history and to wander the beautiful grounds, especially during cherry blossom season when the sakura blooms and the weather is often at its best.

Day 5: 02 April 2024 Kochi, Japan

High atop a hill in Kochi sits 17th century Kochi Castle, once the seat of the Yamauchi lords. Explore this historic site and enjoy panoramic views of the city. For a true taste of Kochi, have something to eat and drink at the Hirome Market. There are dozens of stalls to choose from, all serving a variety of cuisine, including delicious local Kochi dishes.

Day 6: 03 April 2024 Hiroshima, Japan

The city offers visitors a great deal more than the tragedy of the recent past. In addition to the memorials to the events of World War II, there are an array of shrines and temples, as well as the city's reconstructed castle, which was originally founded in the 16th century. Nature lovers will be charmed by the historic Shukkeien Garden, commissioned in 1620, and Miyajima Island, one of the most scenic spots in Japan.

Day 7: 04 April 2024 Busan (Pusan), South Korea

South Korea's second-largest city (after the capital, Seoul), Busan is located in the south eastern corner of the country along the Sea of Japan. It combines a vibrant, big-city atmosphere with a famously laidback attitude and subtropical landscapes. Often described as the "San Francisco of Korea", thanks mainly to its hilly terrain and close-knit neighbourhoods, it offers visitors a little of everything: fashionable boutiques, dynamic culture and busy nightlife, as well as sandy beaches, hot springs and nearby mountains crossed with hiking trails and dotted with temples.



Day 8: 05 April 2024 Sakaiminato, Japan

Sakaiminato is a small fishing town in the north-west end of Tottori Prefecture and offers a unique blend of delicious seafood and fascinating cultural attractions.

Food enthusiasts should not miss trying this snow crab delicacy featured in their local dishes. The city is also home to the manga-themed Mizuki Shigeru Road, where fans can explore shops related to the artist's work.

Day 9: 06 April 2024 Tsuruga, Japan

Tsuruga is a port town right on the coast of Tsuruga Bay south of Fukui Prefecture with a prosperous history as a strategic transportation centre. In addition to its coastline, forests, and wetlands, Tsuruga has ancient temples. It also has well-preserved historical sites that provide a glimpse into times past. It is, of course, famous for seafood.

Day 10: 07 April 2024 Toyama, Japan

Visit the Toyama Castle, an impressive reconstruction of the 1543 original. Take the railway up to Mount Tateyama, the highest mountain in the range, or cruise through a cherry blossom tunnel on the Matsukawa River. Whatever activity you do, take time to savour the region's renowned seafood, elegantly presented in many forms.

Day 11: 08 April 2024 Niigata, Japan

Located along the rugged coast of the Sea of Japan, Niigata is known for its natural splendours and high-quality sake. Unwind in open-air thermal hot springs and refresh with a stroll through a forest, known as shinrin-yoku or forest bathing. See the breathtaking rice fields of the Tokamachi

area, especially resplendent after rainfall. Or head to the Kiyotsu Gorge, a canyon with a tunnel that winds along the river.

Day 12: 09 April 2024 At sea

Day 13: 10 April 2024 Otaru, Japan

The highest vantage point in Otaru is the top of Mt. Tengu, which offers panoramic views of Ishikari Bay, the Shakotan Peninsula, and Otaru. The mountain towers over the city and is a popular ski resort in winter. Take the ropeway up the mountain to enjoy the views. Otaru is also known for its fresh seafood, and abundant hot springs.

Day 14: 11 April 2024 Hakodate, Japan

The picturesque city of Hakodate is renowned for its fresh seafood and spectacular views, while its location at the southern tip of Hokkaido makes it a convenient base for exploring the abundance of nature nearby.

Day 15: 12 April 2024 At sea

Day 16: 13 April 2024 Yokohama (Tokyo), Japan

Meet with your guide when you disembark the ship. Visit Meiji Shrine, a shrine dedicated to the deified spirit of Emperor Meiji and a popular place for traditional Japanese weddings. After visiting the shrine, you will walk down the adjacent Omotesando shopping street, a broad tree lined avenue home to the flagship stores of the world's top fashion brands. After shopping in Omotesando, it's time to cook! You will visit a sushi restaurant for sushi making experience. A Japanese sushi chef will answer all your questions about sushi and Japanese food culture and will

help you to make a selection of delicious fresh sushi. You will then get to enjoy your home-made sushi for lunch. The rest of the afternoon is at your leisure.

Day 17: 14 April 2024 Tokyo, Japan

Today you will visit Hamarikyu garden, an Edo Period Japanese garden surrounded by the Shiodome district's futuristic skyscrapers, a great example of how Japan is the land of contrasts, where you will stop for a cup of steaming matcha and Japanese sweets in a tea house on a small island in the park's lake. From here, you will head to Hinode Pier where you can take a seat on one of the futuristic looking boat and travel up the Sumidagawa River on Tokyo's Water Bus. You will arrive at Asakusa, Tokyo's old town where you can soak in the atmosphere of the Tokyo of old. Visit Sensoji, Tokyo's oldest temple and wander down Nakamise, a shopping street that has been providing temple visitors with a variety of traditional, local snacks and tourist souvenirs for centuries. After lunch (own expense), you will have the unforgettable opportunity to participate in an authentic tea ceremony in Asakusa. Sample freshly made green tea in a Japanese style tearoom nearby. Finally head to Ginza - Tokyo's upmarket district and enjoy its boutiques, art galleries and department stores which all offer the town's finest quality goods.

Day 18: 15 April 2024 Tokyo, Japan
