Day 1: 08 November 2024 Singapore, Singapore

Enjoy your luxury airport lounge access before you depart. Arrive in Singapore and make your own way to the hotel where you will join your fellow travellers.

Visit the BOH Tea Plantation where slopes are filled with tea plants as far as the eye can see; Kea Farm Market Place; and the Time Tunnel Museum, where you get a fascinating glimpse into some the colonial history of the region.

Day 8: 15 November 2024 Taiping – Penang, Malaysia

Journey to Taiping, where historical buildings and heritage landmarks hark back to the colonial era and visit the orangutan rehabilitation and educational centre in Bukit Merah. Afterwards, continue onto Penang.

Day 9: 16 November 2024 Penang, Malaysia

A guided tour showcases Penang's temples, seafront, and water villages. The rest of your day is at leisure.

Day 10: 17 November 2024 Penang, Malaysia

A day of total relaxation or you can choose to explore some more of Penang.

Day 11: 18 November 2024 Penang, Malaysia – Singapore, Singapore

Say goodbye to your fellow travellers before making your way to the airport for your own flight to Singapore. Upon arrival, please make your own way to your hotel for your overnight stay. Relax for the rest of the day or why not catch up on some last-minute shopping.



Day 12: 19 November 2024 Singapore, Singapore - Embark

After checking out of your hotel, please make your way to the port where you will sail to Brisbane onboard Royal Caribbean's Quantum of the Seas.

Day 13 - 14: 20 - 21 November 2024 At sea

Day 15: 22 November 2024 Lombok, Indonesia

The island is home to sacred Mount Rinjani, the second-highest volcano in Indonesia with waterfalls hidden in the volcano's foothills. Along the island's coastline, there's no shortage of sugarsand beaches with clear turquoise waters. The Sasak people, Lombok's largest ethnic group, are known for their creativity and festivals. Under the sunshine in a traditional Sasak village, homes built from clay and bamboo double as textile workshops, and men practise their stick-fighting skills in dusty arenas.

Day 16 - 17: 23 - 24 November 2024 At sea

Day 18: 25 November 2024 Darwin, Australia The capital city of Australia's Northern

Territory, Darwin delivers rugged natural beauty. This port city on Australia's Top End is known for its year-round tropical climate. Why not take in the ocean views at Cullen Bay Marina or cool down inside the Museum and Art Gallery of the Northern Territory. Here, you'll find collections on Cyclone Tracy, Darwin's World War II history and indigenous and Australian art. If you're looking to venture farther out, it's just over an hour to the Kakadu rainforest or the waterfalls and plunge pools of Litchfield National Park.

Day 19 - 20: 26 – 27 November 2024 At sea

Day 21: 28 November 2024 Cairns

Cairns is the gateway to the Great Barrier Reef and Daintree Rainforest. Why not enjoy the city's year-round tropical summer weather as you relax beside the man-made lagoon on the Esplanade. You could maybe experience the rainforest in nearby Kuranda, which you can reach by taking the Skyrail Cableway or the Scenic Railway or even take a halfday trip to Green Island — you'll be snorkelling on the Great Barrier Reef within an hour of leaving the city. So much to see and do - you are free to explore!

Day 22: 29 November 2024 Airlie Beach

Airlie Beach is the mainland town that allows the easiest access to the 74 incredible Whitsunday Islands take the ferry out and spend your day relaxing by clear aqua waters at Whitehaven Beach or snorkelling among the heart-shaped portion of the Great Barrier Reef, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Or stick to the mainland and walk the Bicentennial Walkway along the waterfront, take a dip in Airlie Beach Lagoon, or head to Conway National Park, where you can hike your way through rain forest to panoramic views of the city and the harbor.

Day 23: 30 November 2024 At sea

Day 24: 01 December 2024 Brisbane

Early morning arrival into Brisbane where you will disembark the ship. Make your own way to the airport for your flight home.
