XTREME RACING

In December, we had the opportunity to work with Nico Rosberg, the Finnish-German racing driver! Life Terra worked with his team at Rosberg Xtreme Racing to plant trees in Aragon, an area in Spain that has suffered from forest fires, droughts and erosion due to strong winds. Planting trees is an important initiative to restore degraded land and help reverse the local impact of climate change.

The contribution of the Nico Rosberg team helps to offset approx. 20 Ton of CO2 emissions, this is equivalent to the emissions associated with for example 4 return tickets Berlin-New York.

Nico Rosberg: "The series represents an amazing opportunity to not only drive awareness but also inspire action in the fight against climate change - the single biggest threat to our planet today."

<u>Start of Life Terra's first large scale planting in Portugal in Montemor o Novo on</u> <u>the 15th January 2021</u>

Last week saw the start of an exciting new phase for Life Terra. At the Herdade Freixo do Meio farm in Alentejo, the first 3.000 trees and shrubs were planted to restore an area that has suffered heavily from erosion and lack of vegetation.

The project is executed on behalf of our partner IG&H Consulting of the Netherlands. This Dutch consultancy firm, with a subsidiary in Lissabon, is very concerned about its environmental footprint and has an internal program to realise smarter energy use, paper & plastic savings at the office and electric leasing cars.

We are proud and thankful that <u>IG&H Consulting</u> has chosen Life Terra to compensate any remaining carbon emission.
